TO REMODEL A BLUE SERGE.

Collar and Cuffs of Contrasting Material Would Brighten It Up Wonderfully.

Nearly every business and college girl has at least one serge frock in her wardrobe, which she finds of great importance in her busy workaday life. She always feels comfortable and well dressed if she wears a one-piece dress. But her frock from last season is perhaps a little out of style or dowdy from long wear.

For the ordinary girl there is a charmingly youthful style. Her blue serge frock should be brightened by Roman silk striped with velvet. Dag pockets gathered into a ruffle at the top and of a good size should be sewed on the front of the skirt. A rubber draw-string keeps the gathers in place and yet allows the hands full sway when searching deep into the pocket for pencil, pen-knife, etc.

A collar of Roman silk and velvet should replace the old one. Cut this round in sack and slope it to a point in front. Then cut away the front of the waist in the shape of an inverted V, the point coming at the neck, and into this space set a vestee matching the collar and pockets.

Cut this vestee on the bias so that the stripes meet in points and close it with tiny gift buttons. No cuffs are used, but the sleeves are caught into deep tucks, forming a leg-o-mutton style.

For something out of the ordinary try remodeling your old serge with blue and white striped serge. Purchase the material with stripes about an eighth of an inch wide instead of the half-line variety. From this cut a redingote tunic—a tunic of three-quarter length open down the front.

ANCIENT COLONY GRINDING FLOUR

St. John's Nfld., Dec. 1. — The first flour ever ground in Newfoundland has just come from the mill. Although wheat has been ripened occasionally in previous years under exceptionally favorable conditions, the grain has been used to poultry.

This year a sufficiently large quantity of hardy wheta was matured to justify the importing of a second hand grist mill from Nova Scotia. It is expected that the experiment will be repeated on a larger scale next year.

QUICK AND EASY CAKE FILLING.

Put one teaspoon of powdered sugar into a bowl, add two tablespoonfuls of grated chocolate or cocoa, two tablespoonfuls of boiling hot coffee and one generous tablespoonful of melted butter. Beat until it is of the proper consistency to spread. One teaspoon of vanilla may be added.
