

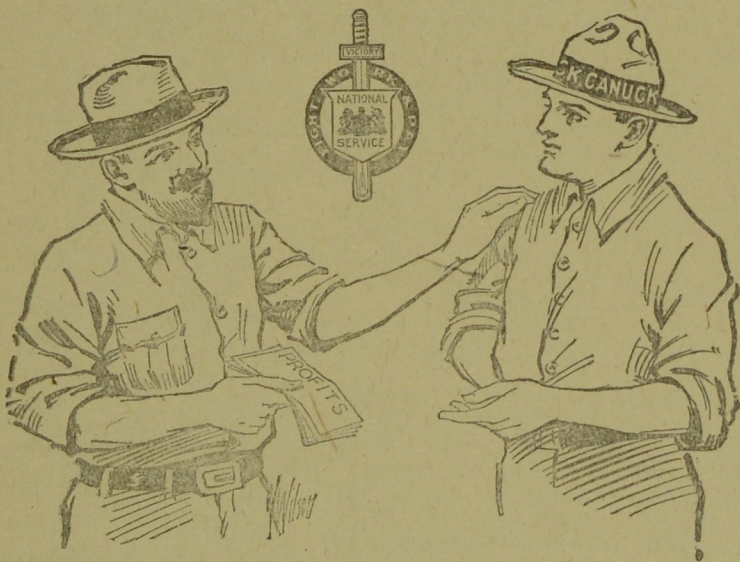

## HON. MR. DUGAL HEARD FROM IN THE BUDGET DEBATE

Man Who Rendered Yeoman Service in Rescuing the Province From the Plaguing Plunderbund, Made a Ringing Speech—His Remarks Heartily Cheered

Hon. Mr. Dugal, speaking on the budget in the Legislature on Wednesday evening requested permission to speak in his own language which was granted. He said that the ex-attorney general had on the previous evening delivered a speech in French at an educational function in Memramcook and had then advocated the study and use of both languages. When he (Dugal) first entered the Legislature he found that he had a considerable task upon his shoulders and that he would have to be a sort of watch-dog. When the hon. provincial secretary of that day brought down his budget he (Dugal) thought that as they spoke the same language he would have been permitted to address the house in French. Having eventually been granted privilege it was given to him (Dugal) to lay before the House charges which brought about a result and a change which the province will never regret. When he preferred his charges on the floors of the House against the late administration he was warned that unless he furnished the proof to establish them he would be disgraced for life and an eight-foot square medal would be struck to commemorate his downfall. They had, however, reckoned without their host with the result that someone else was wearing the medal intended for him. Hon. members opposite had complained that hon. members on the Government side were unable to agree, as to the size of the public debt. The fact of the matter was that under the late administration the affairs of the prov-

ince had got into such a chaotic condition that it was next to impossible to tell exactly how matters stood. The hon. member for Albert found fault because some structural superintendents in his county had been removed. If such officials in Albert county were of the same type as some in Madawaska, who required that the sum of sixty dollars be expended before any work was commenced, he could say that their removal from office did not come any too soon. He noticed that his hon. friends opposite had adopted the same methods which they criticised so much when he (Dugal) had used them when he sat the left of the Speaker. Imitation was the sincerest form of flattery. Although the Government is yet very young he could see by the number of inquiries that had been made that hon. members opposite felt that he (Dugal's) work had produced good results. It was his privilege to probe into the affairs of the late government in the interests of the province and now that he sat on the right of the Speaker he would be equally astute in safeguarding the interests and rights of the people. His sole ambition had been to serve the province faithfully and he did not propose to depart from that line of conduct. He had faith in the ability and integrity of his trusted and honored young leader and he had no doubt but that he would give the province the kind of government it so much needed and which the people showed so plainly on February 24th they were looking for.

#### For the Curling Iron.

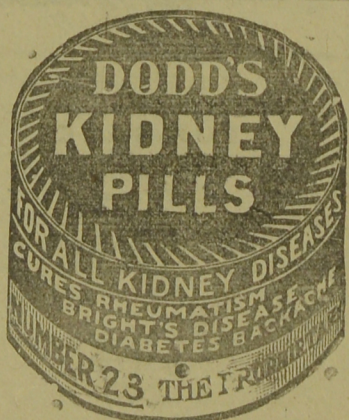

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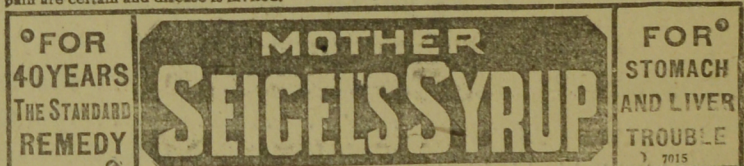
