

SENSATIONAL MURDER TRIAL

(Canadian Press direct wire.)
Dedham, Mass., Dec. 4.—The case of Miss Harriet A. Varney, charged with the murder of Mrs. Pauline A. Keyes, which has come to trial in the superior court here, has presented several angles which have attracted public attention. Mrs. Keyes was found dead in her home in Brookline on June 19 last, ten months after her marriage to George H. Keyes, a real estate dealer, by whom she had been employed as a stenographer. A revolver and a note on the table near the body led the medical examiner to express the opinion that she had committed suicide.

Keyes insisted that his wife had been murdered, and after a further investigation Miss Varney, who is a nurse, was arrested. Relatives and

NO GRAIN NOW FOR LIQUOR

Ottawa, Dec. 4.—The order in council passed upon the recommendation of the food controller prohibiting the use in Canada, for the distillation of potable liquors, of grain of any kind or any substance that can be used for food, became effective December 1. It applies to sugar and molasses equally as to other food materials.



This is an increase over November a year ago of 1,616,331 tons, and brings the season's total to December 1, up to slightly more than 61,500,000 tons.
