THE SIX DAYS BICYCLE RACE

New York, Dec. 8. — Oscar Egg and Pete Drobach started a series of sprints at 4 a. m. today, the final day of the six day bicycle race at Madison Square Garden, which resulted three hours later in the losing of one lap by Genard and Perry. This left seven teams tied in the lead, with Grenda and Piercy one lap behind. Egg and Drobach, to whom the management offered a bonus of \$250 if they regained front group, having been unable to a lap, are still two laps behind the front group, having been unable to

make any headway. The boy team, Chapman and Eager, were hopelessly distanced but still gamely riding.

Twelve points, instead of six, will be awarded to the winners of each of the five mile sprints this afternoon, and 72 points to the winners of the regular sprints tonight which will decide the division of the cash prizes.

HISTORY repeats itself. Look back to a time when a nation was faced with a crisis similar to that which confronts us to-day. EX-CZAR MADE A GETAWAY

Washington, Dec. 8. — The American consul at Tiflis today reported a rumor that the former czar of Russia has escaped. The message contained no details and made it clear that there was no confirmation of the rumor. No other news was received here today from Russia.

TO REPUDIATE LOAN
(Canadian Press direct wire.)

London, Dec. 8. — The Bolshevik government, according to a Reuter despatch from Petrograd, is preparing a decree repudiating all Russian foreign loans and loans concluded by land, banks and railways on government guarantees. Shares of internal loans held abroad also will be repudiated.

DENIES VATICAN IS NOT NEUTRAL

London, Dec. 8. — Cardinal Bourne, archbishop of Westminster, has communicated to the Morning Post a statement from Cardinal Gasparri, the Papal secretary of state, answering the Post's accusation that the Vatican was implicated in disruptive propaganda.

da in Italy and is unneutral.

Cardinal Gasparri denounces the accusation as an "atrocious calumny" and says the hierarchy and clergy in Italy have given open and generous help to the country's cause and have received unreserved praise from the Italian parliament and government. The cardinal adds that long before the issuance of the papal note, which is said to have been among the chief causes of the army's lowered morale, the clergy generally and the army chaplains particularly were laboring against the destructive propaganda which was reported to be giving unrest to the civil authorities.

The vatican, the cardinal declares is pained and indignant at the Post's charges and regards them as insulting. Referring to the accusation that the vatican espoused the Austrian cause, Cardinal Gasparri reaffirms the

full and correct neutrality of the Holy See.

"The supreme pontiff" he concludes, "does not depend for instruction upon those who long before the war worked to diminish the authority which they are now invoking, nor does the Holy See shape its action by the flickering lights of human praise or blame."

The Post in an editorial article virtually reiterates its original accusation and cites incidents which it regards as proofs.
