

## SOME NEW RECIPES.

## BRAN GEMS.

Mix together one quart of bran, one pint flour, one pint milk, 12 tablespoonfuls molasses, one table-spoonful soda and a pinch of salt. Bake in gem pans.

## BEEFSTEAK WITH OYSTERS.

Get a nice tender beefsteak and fry it. After it is fried take it out of the pan and place it on a plate. To the pan that had the beefsteak in put in about 10 or 15 cents' worth of stewing oysters, also the uice. Let cook a while, then pour over the steak.

## DELICIOUS FRIDAY DISH.

One can salmon, chopped fine (pint size); four eggs, beaten, one-half cup melted butter, one-half cup bread crumbs, pepper, salt, parsley. Bake one hour in buttered dish.

Sauce for same— One table-spoon cornstarch, salmon liquor, one large spoon butter, one raw egg, one teaspoon catsup, mace, cayenne. Boil one minute and pour over pudding mold.

POPE TO DELIVER  
IMPORTANT MESSAGE

ROME, March 13.—It is still asserted in Vatican circles that the Pope will not include in the allocution which he will deliver to the Consistory on March 22 any political passage, but it is believed that this is done not in order to arouse expectations, and that the Pontiff is really preparing a new and important statement regarding the international situation.

Those who hold this view point to the long conversation which the Pope had had with the two English cardinals, Gasquet and Bourne, the latter having remained in Rome for about four months, despite pressing affairs urging his return to his work at Westminster. The Pope has also conferred with Mgr. Billet, a French cardinal with Mgr. Fruhwirth, a German cardinal living in Rome, and also Father Dominic Reuter, ex-General of the Capuchin order, director of the office, collecting information about prisoners in all the belligerent countries.



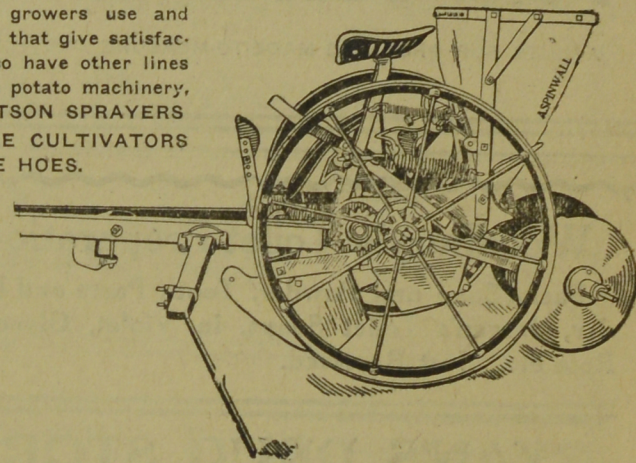

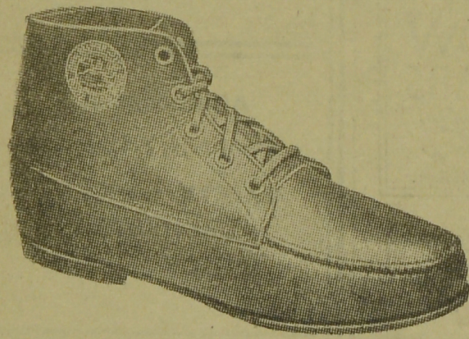
