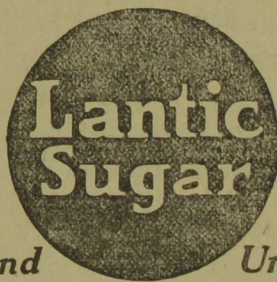

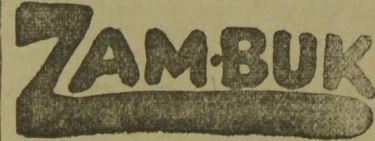

## H. H. McLEAN NOW MAJOR GENERAL

Ottawa, Nov. 22. — Militia orders issued today contain the official announcement that General Hugh McLean has been transferred to the retired list, and is granted the honorary rank of major-general.

General McLean was Liberal member for Sunbury-Queens, N.B., and is the Unionist candidate for the new constituency of Royal.

The announcement is made that Sir Charles Ross, temporary colonel, has ceased to be employed as a consulting officer on small arms ammunition and has relinquished his temporary military rank.

## DOING WELL FOR VICTORY LOAN

Quebec, Nov. 22. — Gratifying progress was made yesterday in the city by the committee in charge of the Victory Loan campaign. Several large subscriptions were received, amongst them these: Beckett & Company, \$50,000; Mr. William Shaw, \$50,000; Clinic Hardware Company, \$40,000; Mr. L. H. Gaudry, Riviere Ouelle Lumber Company, Mr. Herman Young, \$25,000 each.

The amount subscribed in Quebec city up to Tuesday night is \$2,000,000 and it is now anticipated that the \$5,000,000 mark set for Quebec city will be reached and even surpassed if Quebecers keep up the good work.

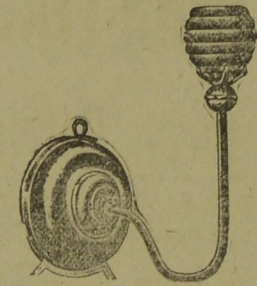
