Counter offensives by the Germans later resulted in withdrawal of the Russian forces which had advanced.


CABINET COUNCILS

In England Cabinet Councils are conducted in the strict privacy, al-though very occasionally important officials and other outsiders have at-tended a meeting for the purpose of giving information or advice on specific matters; while the remark-able step was taken of inviting Sir Robert Borden, as Prime Minister of Canada, to attend one of the meetings while he was in England. Otherwise the most stringent measures are the most stringent measures are adopted to secure the inviolability of Cabinet proceedings. Trusted jani-tors keep watch outside to guard against the possibility of eavesdrop-ping, while the very blotting pads are destroyed after each meeting lest they should betray anything that has taken







