### DON'T FORGET CHEESE.

Don't, in your enthusiasm and interest in trying out soy beans and macaroni and nuts as meat substitutes, forget the good old standby, cheese. It can be used to such good advantage, and it can be prepared in so many ways as a palatable substitute for meat, that it should always be counted on by the economical housekeeper.

Here are some good dishes in which cheese is largely used:

#### Cheese and Macaroni Loaf.

One-half cup of macaroni, one cup milk, one cup soft breadcrumbs, one tablespoon each butter, chopped green pepper, one teaspoon each chopped onion, chopped parsley, three eggs, one teaspoon salt, one-half cup grated cheese.

Cook the macaroni, broken into small pieces, in boiling salted water until tender, and rinse in cold water. Cook the onion, parsley and pepper in a little water with the butter. Pour off the water or allow it to boil away. Beat the egg, white and yolk separately. Mix all ingredients, cutting and folding in the stiff beaten eggs at the last. Line a quart baking dish with a buttered paper; turn the mixture into it, set the baking dish in a pan of hot water and bake in a moderate oven 40 minutes. Serve with tomato sauce.

#### Scalloped Tomatoes with Cheese.

One can of solid tomatoes, four large green peppers, six onions, one-half lb. American cheese, one-eighth teaspoon pepper, one tablespoon olive oil, one and one-third cup dry bread crumbs, one teaspoon salt.

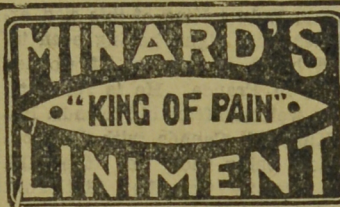
Stew the tomatoes, pepper and the onions together with the oil and seasonings until tender. Grate the cheese. Butter a casserole, put in a layer of the tomato mixture, then cheese and crumbs and repeat in this way till all is used. Make the top layer of crumbs dot with butter and bake half an hour in a moderate oven.

#### Potatoes with Cheese.

Two cups cream sauce, one and one-half cups grated cheese. Mix together. Add sliced cold boiled potatoes. Season well with salt and pepper and bake in a buttered dish until brown on the top.

#### Macaroni and Cheese.

Boil Macaroni cut into small pieces in salt water for 20 minutes. Drain in colander. Butter a baking dish and arrange a layer of macaroni and cover with a layer of sliced or grated cheese. Repeat until dish is full. Cover with sweet milk and dot with bits of butter and bake until brown. The top layer should be of cheese.
