1. Great care should be taken that everything is perfectly sweet that goes into the pot

2. Meat and bones should be broken into convenient sizes.

3. In summer if stock is to be left a day or two, omit the vegetables, and heat to the boiling point every day. 4. In winter stock will keep a week

or more Directions for Making Stock from a Tough Piece of Meat.

- 1. Cut meat into small pieces 2. Let soak half an hour in cold water.
- 3. Heat to simmering point.
- 4. Simmer ten to twelve hours
- 5. Add vegetables two or three hours
- 6. Strain stock from the meat and
