

HELPFUL HINTS FOR HARD TIMES.

A nice way to repair a pair of cotton blankets (the double ones) when the centre becomes worn is to buy two yards of plan outing flannel to match the blanket and cut next the stripe and set the outing in with a flat seam. The blankets will wear nearly as long as new ones and do not show the mend.

To mend children's stockings take the stocking leg off the foot and lay it flat on a lady's stocking. Cut about a half inch larger than the child's stocking putting the top of each stocking together. Begin at the toe and by being careful you can make several pairs in a few minutes, stitching them on the sewing machine.

A good use for old table cloths is to cut into pieces in a manner to leave out the worn parts, and hemstitch. These make very good tray cloths.
