PIGS IMPROVE PATRIOTISM

Norway, a little Maine town of three thousand people, made a remarkable showing in all kinds of war work. One of the side issues was a pig raising plan devised by Talbot Mundy, the novelist.

You can buy a very young pig for \$5—or could at least a short time ago in Norway. So Mundy evolved this plan: He got a good many small farmers and families who had a little ground around their houses, to agree to keep a pig—if the pig were furnished. Again, he worked along cooperative lines. Most of the people he approached either couldn't or wouldn't spend \$5 for a pig. And they were disposed to balk, too, at the prospective cost of upkeep—because even a pig costs something to feed.

"If I get you the pig," said Mundy, "will you pay half the cost of feeding and keeping him if I find someone to pay the other half? You look after the pig and pay half the cost—and own a half interest in the pig. The person who buys him and pays the other half of the cost of feed owns the other half. You divide the proceeds when he's sold. How's that?"

It was all right. So Mundy, with his pledges tabulated, set out to find sponsors and godfathers for pigs.

There are people all over New England, in New York, in Chicago, in Philadelphia, who own half a pig in Norway now. They clamor for pictures of them, too—Mundy has sent dozens of snapshots he has taken of pigs in various stages of growth, which are now being proudly shown by their vicarious owners.

About 140 pigs were raised in and around Norway last summer on Mundy's co-operative plan!

Next summer there will be more, many more. He has a waiting list of people who want to own half a pig.

FRENCH AND BRITISH TROOPS IN SUCCESSES

London, May 1. — French troops last night improved their positions in the neighborhood of Loire, on the Flanders front, the war office announces. The British rushed German posts in the Meteren sector and took prisoners.

PRINCE SIXTUS CONCERNED IN PEACE MOVE

(Canadian Press direct wire.)

London, May 1. — Prince Sixtus of Bourbon-Parma, to whom the famous letter written by Emperor Charles offering peace to France was addressed the Times says, visited King Alfonso of Spain on Monday, according to the Madrid Sol. He was accompanied by his brother Prince Xavier, and the Spanish newspaper understands that he gave to King Alfonso explanations on the subject of his correspondence with his Hapsburg relatives. His sister is empress of Austria-Hungary. The prince, it is added, and the fact may be of significance, declares the Times, left the Spanish capital for the Belgian front. Simultaneously a report from Stockholm stated that Emperor Charles was making a fresh peace attempt and that he was appealing to Italy to consider it in her own interests.

All that can be said about these rumors, the Times adds, is that they are not inherently creditable.

NOTICE

NOTICE is hereby given to all residents, non-residents and corporations, whether within or without the Province, in compliance with "An Act respecting the taxation of Wild Lands" passed 11th April, 1918, to file with the Minister of Lands and Mines at the Crown Land Office in Fredericton, on or before the first of July, 1918, a statement of the number of acres subject to the tax as provided by the Act; parishes where the land is situated; what fractional part of the interest in said lands is held by resident and by non-resident owners, or if owned by a corporation, what fractional part of the stock is held by resident and by non-resident stockholders and the name and address of the manager, managing owner or managing director of said land.

Upon failure to comply with this demand an additional tax of one cent per acre may be imposed, not exceeding in the whole the sum of \$30 in addition to the tax as prescribed by the Act.

Taxes are payable at the Crown Land Office in Fredericton on or before the first of September, 1918, and remittances can be forwarded in the name of T. G. Loggie, Deputy Minister of Lands and Mines.
