In the spring beekeepers nearly al ways have some colonies light in stores while others have more than they require. With straight combs this matter can be regulated by giving a comb of honey from the rich colony to the starving one. In swarming time some beekeepers make a prac tice of placing a frame of unsealed brood in the centre of the hive before hiving the swarm. This is considered a sure method of holding the swarm and well worthy of a trial by any one. As long as we keep bees in hives the frames of which cannot be hand led we are working in the dark and can never expect success by any such

haphazard methods.
