WARM WEATHER RECIPES.

Frozen Custard.

1 pint milk, 1 cup corn syrup, maple syurp or honey, 11/2 tsp. cornstarch, 11/2 tsp. cold milk or water, 1/8 tsp. of salt, 11/2 tsp. vanilla. Scald the milk and add the cornstarch mixed with the cold milk or water. Cook the mixture over hot water for 15 minutes. Add the egg, slightly beaten, and cook the corn syrup and the salt and stir the mixture well. Strain it and cool it. Add the vanilla and freeze the custard in the same way as any ice cream.

Pineapple Sherbet.

1 cup corn or other syrup, 1 cup of grated pineapple, 2 cups boiling water, juice of 1 lemon, white of 1 egg. Combine the ingredients with the exception of the egg white. Cool the mixture and freeze it. Add the beaten

1 egg, half cup milk, 2 tablespoons orn or other syrup, 1/2 tsp vanil beat the mixture with an egg beater flavoring. Stir the mixture thoroughly and serve it ice cold.

SUMMER CARE OF BABIES.

Everything of Course Depends on the Matter of Food.


