

## "ON THE WAY TO MUSQUODOBOITS"

Attractions, Resources, Possibilities of the Famous Valley Described in New C. G. R. Booklet.

Among the attractive booklets recently issued by the Publicity Department of the Canadian Government Railways is one devoted exclusively to the Musquodoboit Valley branch and all connected with it. A large section of the well compiled and interesting reading matter refers to the City of Halifax, its historic associations, commercial prominence and possibilities, its close touch with the military and naval services of the Empire, its unparalleled Harbor, Basin and Arm, its Public Gardens and beautiful surroundings, etc. The town of Dartmouth, as the starting point of the Musquodoboit Branch Railway, likewise receives attention, and reference is made to its business prosperity and beautiful surroundings.

Under the heading "On the way to the Musquodoboits," there is given a description of the branch line and of the towns and villages passed through the manufacturing, fertile lands, sporting facilities, gold mines, etc. The great lumbering operations and possibilities in that direction are pointed out and the beauty of the streams along the branch is remarked upon. The booklet contains maps of Nova Scotia and of the whole Halifax-Musquodoboit district, showing plainly to the eye just what places are served by the railway.

"The Valley," it says, "has been the home of some of the ablest men which the Dominion has produced, men high in the affairs of church and state. Her people are a hospitable folk, and the stranger in her midst is assured a courteous welcome. Musquodoboit has crossed the Rubicon—henceforth her progress will be in keeping with the renewed energy of her people and the richness of her resources." — Halifax Chronicle.

## BROUGHT DOWN SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATES

(Canadian Press direct wire.)

Ottawa, May 20.—Hon. A. K. MacLean, acting Minister of Finance, in the Commons this morning tabled supplementary estimates totalling \$46,957,312. The total is an unusually large one because it includes a vote of \$37,000,000 to cover the working expenses of the Canadian government railways. This large item is almost invariably included in the main estimates brought down earlier in the session. Of the amount asked for, only \$5,170,313 is chargeable to expenditure.

The vote of most general interest is one providing the sum of \$3,000,000 to assist government employees in the outside service who are in receipt of comparatively small salaries.

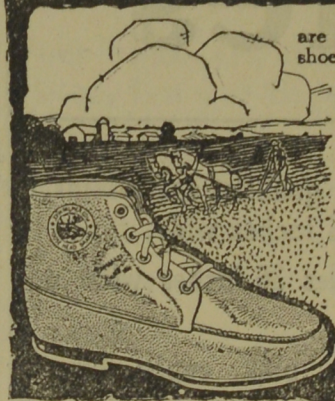
