

## OF INTEREST TO WOMEN

FOR MEATLESS DAYS

### Vegetable Soup.

Dice ten small potatoes, ten small onions; cook in two quarts of boiling water about one hour, then add one-third of a cup of evaporated milk and 1 tablespoonful of butter or dripping, half a cup of leftover beans and any leftover meat, cut fine. This is good without the meat; it makes a good dish for luncheon on a cold day and will be enough for six persons.

### Salmon Dish.

Into a pan pour one large can of salmon, sprinkle with salt, pepper and a spoonful of butter substitute. Beat four eggs good, pour over salmon, stirring well, mashing well with a fork. Cook till grainy and rather dry. Will serve five persons and is a delicious, healthy war dish.

### Finnan Haddie Fish Balls.

Freshen the finnan haddie and pick up as you would codfish. To two cups of finnan haddie use one cup of white sauce, made with a quarter of a teaspoon of flour and butter.

### Fish Hash.

One can fish flaked, two cups of cold boiled potatoes, salt and pepper to taste. Melt some drippings in frying pan. Cut potatoes as for frying and mix with the fish. Add seasonings and stir these into frying pan. Stir until mixed with drippings. Then allow to brown. Makes an appetizing dish.

### Bean Croquettes.

One cup milk, boil and stir in one heaping tablespoonful flour, moistened, to thicken, 2 cups cold cooked navy or lima beans, a little salt to taste. Let cool then put in enough bread crumbs to be able to make into patties and fry a delicate brown. Will serve six or eight.

### Meatless Hints.

Try salt fish as cakes, or soufflé or hash. Serve with or without tomato sauce.

Try fish chowders and vegetable chowders, like corn and parsnips. Vary fish chowders by using milk sometimes and tomato other times.

Try cheese in soufflé, omelets, rare-bits and with macaroni.
