BOYS TO CONTINUE DRIVE TO ROUT YELLOW WAR DOGS

Patriotic Youths of Brooklyn Are to Extend Offensive Into Manhattan Until the Lukewarm Americans Are Silenced--- Watching for Sedition --- Boys Doing Men's Work

New York, Aug. 27.—About three hundred members of the Brooklyn Council of Anti-Yellow Dog Clubs gathered in the Broadway Theatre yesterday morning and started a movement to organize a great anti-yellow dog club in the borough of Manhattan.

They also started a drive by which all the pro-German "yellow dogs" in this borough will be rounded up and made to see the error of their ways.

All the members of the Anti-Yellow Dog Clubs are boys—American boys who are patriotic and loyal and who detest the enemies of their country—German, half-German, pro-German, pacifist, lukewarm Americans,—anyone who is not wholly and enthusiastically for Uncle Sam.

Through the courtesy of the manager of the Broadway Theatre, the boys were treated to a free moving picture show in addition to hearing a number of speeches and recitations, including a speech by Henry Irving Dodge, whose story, "The Yellow Dog," published several months ago, started the anti-yellow dog movement throughout the country.

The objects of the Anti-Yellow Dog

Clubs are set forth on the membership cards, many of which were distributed by the Brooklyn boys to Manhattan boys yesterday. They are:

"If a man talks against the government and can't back up what he says, he's a yellow dog."

The meanest yellow dog of the lot is the one that stands up and hears his country abused without protest.

Friendly Criticism.

"Any man who tells the government about its faults and how to correct them is its friend; any man who tells the government about its faults just to discourage, is a yellow dog."

"Any man who won't buy a Liberty bond isn't willing to pay his share of the expenses of our brothers in the trenches. Can any yellow dog be lower than that?"

"Anybody that says United States bonds ain't the safest investment in the world is a yellow dog."

"Anybody that says anything that gives the Germans a chance to write home an' say this ain't a popular war is a yellow dog. It's popular, an' then some."

promise is a yellow dog. Judas made a fifty-fifty peace with the devil. Every body knows where Judas got off.

"All yellow dogism is made in Germany."

"Stop every yellow dog you meet and ask him 'How do you know?'"

"Try to trace the story to the man lower down—to the Hun agent that started the story."

Every member of an Anti-Yellow Dog Club is a boy detective who is working for Uncle Sam. If he hears a soap box orator making sedicious statements he and his fellows yell in chorus, "How do you know?" Many of such orators have been so interrupted in Brooklyn by the boys, and have retired in disgust.

Watching for Sedition

If a boy hears any one saying anything against the United States or spreading any kind of pro-German propaganda, that boy, if he is a member of an Anti-Yellow Dog Club, makes it his business to get the name and address of the sedicious talker, and reports him to the government, or to the police, or to one of the patriotic societies that investigate such matters. In mild cases the boy may be satisfied to hand to the spreader of sedition a small yellow card, on which is printed "summons" calling upon the man to examine his conscience and discover for himself whether or not he has behaved like a yellow dog.

Mr. Dodge made an address in which he said in part:—

"You and I are either too young or too old to go to the front. We are outside the draft age, but, thank God, we are not outside of the fighting age, either of us."

"Don't worry about silly, thoughtless criticism. Why, the other day a critic said:—'Fighting the yellow dog is a good idea, but it doesn't belong to a boy. It's a man's job.'"

Boys Doing Men's Jobs

"So it is a man's job, but the boys are doing it. These are war times; all the jobs are men's jobs, and when a boy does one he measures up to the stature of a man. You're living through one of the most awful crises of the world's history. No boy ever had such an experience before. Our ship's in a frightful storm. Every one must lend a hand. I was going to say every man within the ages of eighteen and forty-five, but I'll change it and make it every male and female between the ages of eight and eighty. They've all got to do men's jobs nowadays."

"Men must talk. If they can't talk evil they must talk good, even of the government. We must stop their wagging their poor foolish jaws to weaken us. If they wage them at all it must be in favor of Uncle Sam."

In closing Mr. Dodge asked the boys to keep their eyes open to detect the pro-German yellow dogs who have been destroying or mutilating patriotic posters on the fences, especially Flagg's great marine recruiting poster "Tell That to the Marines."

W. B. Roulstone, of the American Defence Society, made a speech in which he assured the boys that the society will back them to the limit in their good work.

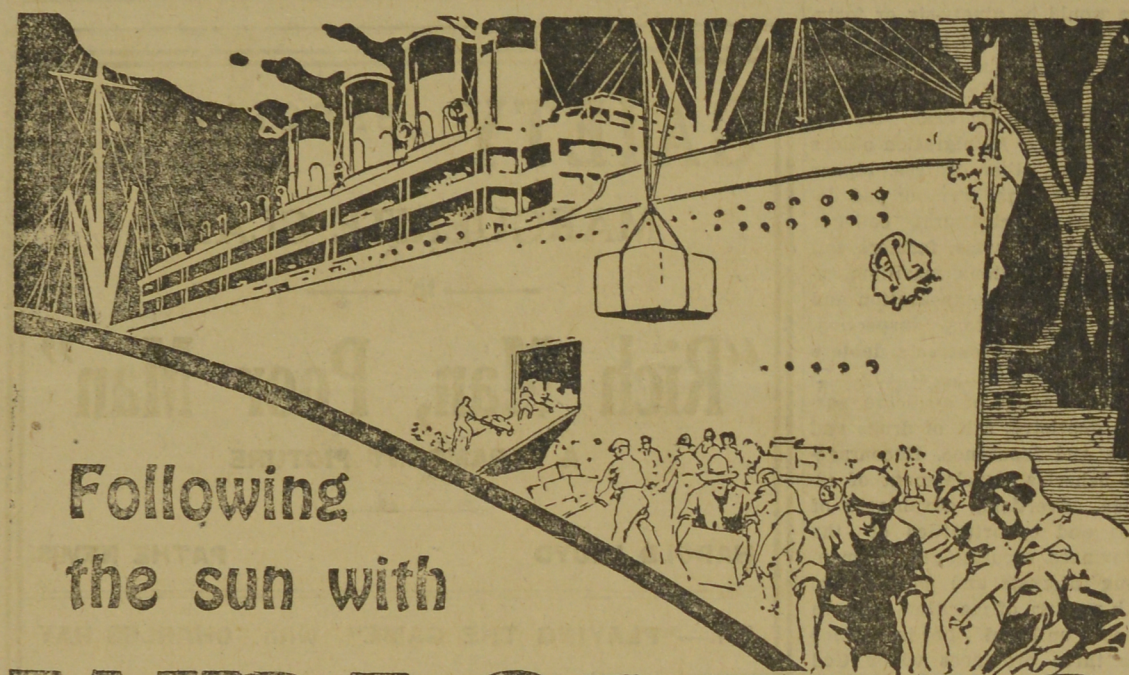
