SENSIBLE FOOTWEAR.

New Sport Oxfords Ideally Comfortable, and Wool Stockings are Correct for Sport Wear.

The medical profession, which has rallied so long at woman's choice of boots and stockings for out of door wear, should find nothing to criticize in the modern sport shoe and wool hose, which are just now ultra-correct for walking and general wear with informal costumes of sport character.

Not only are the new sport oxfords alluringly smart, but they are also ideally comfortable, and once woman has discovered the good qualities of wool stockings she will not be likely to give them up.

Encased in wool hose, the feet tire much less easily in the rather heavy shoes that are absolutely necessary for real tramping and out of door exercise.

Many women who claim they simply cannot wear stout soled shoes and who therefore cling to turned soles and high heels, even in the country, will find that the substitution of wool stockings for thin silk ones makes all the difference in the world.

The heavier stocking keeps the heavier shoe from rubbing and bruising a tender foot, and of course the heavier shoe is imperative if one is to get any enjoyment out of long walks over the rough roads.

And the new wool stockings are particularly smart and also are very picturesque with mahogany colored oxfords. English women wear wool stockings when in the country, partly because such hosiery belongs to the realm of correct sport raiment and no doubt partly because in England there are few verandas and people sit about in chairs on the lawn, and English grass is almost always wet.

Try a pair of wool stockings with your tennis or golf shoes and see how springy and untired your step is, even after a long and arduous game.
