

The seed box or flat, which is kept in the house, is the most practical device for this purpose. It should be not deeper than three inches, from 12 to 14 inches wide and about 20 to 24 inlong. When plants are 11/2 inches high. thin out to 2 inches apart in the row. This gives them space enough to make a strong stocky growth. If you wish you can keep the plants thinned out by setting out in similar boxes.

When tomato plants are about 5 or 6 inches high, thin out to 4 or five inches apart. The thinned out plants may be set one each in berry boxes. Then when finally planted into the garden, the bottom of the box is cut away and the box sunk in the soil in the permanent location without disturbing the roots.
