AGAIN THE CRANBERRY.

The winter season brings with it a native fruit as delicious as any summer berry. In some families cranberries are used only on holidays, but their cheapness and their pteousness should make them more frequently used.

The cranberry contains a strong acid which it is better to neutralize in cooking by the addition of a tiny pinch of baking soda, rather than use such a quantity of sugar, which is expensive, and which never neutralizes the acid, but merely disguises it.


