Fish Chowder.

1 onion sliced, 6 tablespoons drippings, 2 cups carrots cut in pieces, 9 potatoes peeled and cut in small pieces, 2 tablespoons flour, 3 cups of milk, 1½ lbs, fish (fresh, salt or canned) and pepper.

Cook the chopped onion with the fat for five minutes. Put fat, onion, carrots and potatoes in kettle and cover with boiling water. Cook until vegetables are tender. Mix the three tablespoonfuls flour with one-half cup of the cold milk and stir in the liquid in the pot to thicken. Add the rest of the milk and the fish which has been removed from the bone and cut into small pieces. Cook until the fish is tender, about ten minutes. Serve hot Scotch Soup.

2½ quarts water, 1½ pcus rolled oats, 5 potatoes cut in small pieces, 2 tablespoonfuls flour, 2 tablespoonfuls fat. Boil the water and add the rolled oats, the potato and onion and seasonings. Cook for one-half hour. Brown the flour with the fat and add to the soup. Cook until thick.
