POTATO FLOUR SPONGE CAKE

Potato flour sponge cake is one of the best of the war cakes. It uses no fat, of course-no sponge cake uses fat. And it can be made without any white flour. It does call for sugar But as it is entirely free from flour and fat it may be allowed to absorb the little sugar it needs. Moreover, it does not need a frosting, for sponge cake is usually considered better without one

Here is the recipe for it: Beat four egg yolks. Eggs are not so expensive now that four seem a bad allotment cup of sugar and a teaspoonful o vanilla or lemon juice. Beat the four whites, and add to this mixture and then stir in half a cup of potato flour sifted with a teaspoon of baking powder. Flour a bread pan or a flat pan and pour in the cake. Bake in a moderate oven for thirty minutes.

Now it is possible to vary dessert on this potato sponge cake so that you can use it at least once a week Of course it is good with cut up fruit or with berries for luncheon.

Then, if you live in a region where cream is plentiful you can make quite a bit of the centre-which can be used for cabinet pudding or trifle Fill the cavity with vanilla ice cream If you have cream, cover the ice cream and the edges of the cake with WANTED-Books and magazines for whipped cream marked off into squares and in the centre of each square place or going overseas.
