our sister province. The loss of property and of life, and the awful suffering inflicted upon the victims of that appalling catastrophe stirred the whole continent to sympathy and to activity. We watch with confidence and admiration the endeavors Halifax is putting forth to recover herself and to rise from her ruins, her courage and zeal undiminished.

The Great War.

In this, the fourth year of the greatest war the world has ever known, we find ourselves as undaunted and determined to see it through to a conclusive victory as when our first battalions crossed the sea to do and die for home and country and liberty. Many have gone since then—many will never come back but to the glory and honor of both living and dead let it be noted that wherever the fight has been thickest, the danger greatest and the depending issue most grave, there has been found the Canadian soldier; and never yet has he failed to respond with all the vigor and courage and fearlessness of his hardy young manhood to the exigencies of the hour, whatever they were or wherever they took him.

That the spirit of those who perforce have been left at home is not lacking has been amply demonstrated, as His Honor has observed, by their generous response to all patriotic effort. The support given the

Stevens Commission.

We thank His Honor for the assurance that the report of the Commission appointed to inquire into contracts entered into, and acts performed by the directors and officials of the St. John & Quebec Railway Company is to be laid before the House, and we are prepared to give this report very attentive consideration.

The members of this House may differ with each other in political opinions, but every hon. gentleman will recognize and support legislation which has for its purpose the prevention of irregularities such as made it necessary to appoint a Commissioner to investigate the affairs of the St. John & Quebec Railway Company. The business of this province should be so conducted that there would be no occasion for such investigations. There should be no difficulty about carrying on the affairs of the country in an honest and economical manner, with proper regard for what is due the people who look to us to safeguard their interests and protect their rights. Any legislation designed to secure the redress of wrongs committed against the province in connection with the St. John & Quebec Railway in the past, and to provide greater safeguards for the future, must be acceptable to every hon. member of this House.

Public Health.

By all odds the most valuable asset of our province is the general health of its people, and consequently the conservation of this human resource is essential to make more adequate use of our natural resources. At the inception of the Commission of Conservation so broad an interpretation was placed upon the term "natural resources" that it recognized the promotion of Public Health as an essential phase of its activities.

The report recently completed by Mr. John Hall covering the health conditions in this province is indeed alarming in its revelations. It strips us of such complacency as we have permitted ourselves to enjoy and places us at least a decade behind the times in the supervision of our public health.

It is quite time that we adopted some adequate policy for remedying the situation as it now exists, and took some steps toward the safeguarding of the general health of our population. The failure to do so in
