

WIN-THE-WAR RECIPES.

> Salmon Loaf. 1 cup salmon (cold, boiled)

2 eggs, ½ cup bread crumbs,

1 tablespoon butter, 1/4 teaspoon salt,

1/4 teaspoon pepper, 1 tablespoon minced parsley, A little grated onion if liked.

Put in a butter-ed mould and steam three-quarters of an hour. Turn out and serve with a white sauce. Canned salmon may be used or any other cold boiled fish.
