Miller said he would go to Kansas City for a conference with Fred Fulton's manager, but if he could not arrange a match between Willard and Fulton, he would open negotiations with Jack Dempsey.

I am of opinion that a complete settlement of this matter could be easily reached on the following basis, viz., that the interest of the society and the interest of the city be jointly transferred to a body of trustees composed of a judge of the Supreme Court, the mayor of the city for the time being, and the president of the society for the time being, to be held by them in trust for the uses and purposes of the Agricultural Society under its charter, and failing that, that the property revert to and become the absolute property of the city. The nature of the trust should be carefully defined, but in a general way the above represents my idea and I have no doubt after having discussed the matter with many of the directors of the society that they would be prepared to adopt some such scheme as this. I therefore suggest that a special committee be struck to meet the directors of the society with a view to consummating some such scheme of settling this matter.

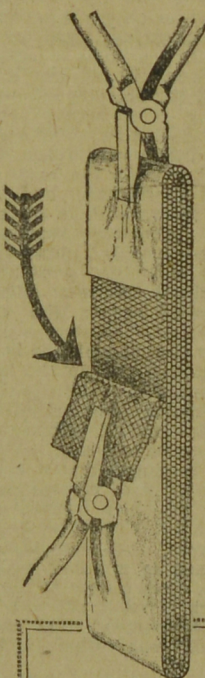

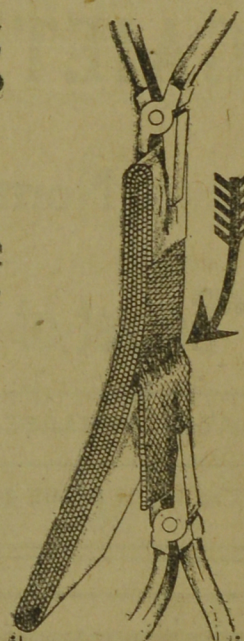
