

HOW GERMAN The Rush From Reconstructed

Villages as the Devastating German Hordes Came on Again.

(New York Sun.)

The havoc, devastation and suffer ng which with the start of the Ger tle rebuilt villages of Picardy, just set led once more in the peaceful ways of home, are described in a letter re ceived by the American Committee for Devastated France from Mrs.

Her letter is the first to reach the United States with the story of the evacuation of the French villages under the pressure of the German guns. It gives a vivid recital of one of the saddest phases of the war.
