OF INTEREST TO WOMEN

NINE DISH-WASHING HINTS.

Use two pans, one for washing, filled with hot soapy water, the other for rinsing, filled with clear hot water.

Use a clean dish cloth and plenty of clean dry towels. Always use fresh towels for glass or silver.

Wash cleanest dishes first; glass, cups and saucers, pitchers and all fine china, fruit plates, etc. Take fresh, hot, soapy water for silver.

Do not put many dishes at one time in the pan. A large amount of soap or soap powder is likely to destroy all gilt and coloring on finely ornamented china.

Very fine china and cut glass should not be washed in very hot water. Rinse in water of same temperature as that in which it was washed.

Large pieces of silver should be washed and rinsed in hot water and wiped inside, but not outside.

Knives with handles of bone, mother of pearl or ivory must never be left in water.

APPLE SAUCE.

When making apple sauce, don't peel

G.T.R. DIFFICULTLY STILL UNSETTLED

Stratford, Ont., Jan. 8. — "We have failed to come to any agreement with the company and have broken off negotiations. We have asked the government for a board of conciliation."

So declared John Semple, chairman of the G.T.R. board that has been negotiating with the Grand Trunk since last November, on his return from Montreal. The federal trades of Canada, including machinists, boiler makers, blacksmiths, electricians, pipe fitters in the G.T.R. from Sarnia to Montreal, are affected — about 1,300 men.

The men asked a minimum wage, a nine-hour day, recognition of their grievance committee and a definition of the different trades. The bone of contention seemed to be recognition of the union.
