In our own country we have not yet been driven to such extremities as in the European countries, but the price of leather and footgear has risen enor mously, and we are diligently seeking both leather substitutes and new sour ces of supply. The skins of equation

animals offer a practically undevel oped resource, and it is not unlikely that before long we shall be covering our extremities with the skins of the man-eating shark and the sacred cod-

Recent experiments at Pratt Institute, Brooklyn, have demonstrated that a marketable leather can be obtained from this source. The reason we have not heretofore utilized the skins of equatic animals for leather is not because they are not perfectly well adapted for such use but only be cause the skins of land animals have been so plentiful. The shoes made from shark skins cannot be disting. uished from those made of other leathers and the wearing qualities seem to be superior.

Since there is no question of the excellence of aquatic leather it is not likely that there will be a considerable development of this source of supply. The Bureau of Fisheries has been experimenting with these skins and reports that already several companies are in the market for the raw hides of sharks and porpoises.






