The approach of colder weather has called attention again to the armies in Palestine, where "renewed activity has just been reported. Little has been heard of late of the Palestine campaign and the reason is not far to seek. The hot season has been prevalent there and little could be done. After taking Jerusalem and driving the Turks from the immediate region north of the city the fighting subsided and both sides awaited the return o

cooler weather. The Turks at least did, but there has been stern activity back of the British lines. The railroad to Egypt has been improved and strengthened the bridge across the Suez canal has been completed and abundant supplies have been forwarded from Egypt

Criticism of Great Britain has been voiced for conducting what has been called this "side issue" campaign, instead of concentrating on the Western front. But the British are wise and they look ahead. Besides, much of the material and many of the men for this campaign comes from the East, and could not easily reach the Western

And in this connection a recent dispatch from Copenhagen states that the British Embasy there has sent an Bureau, the world organization of Jews, which is located in Copenhagen inviting it to make known its attitude toward the participation of a Jewish State in a possible League of Nations.

Taken in conjunction with the Palestine campaign this is a significant feature of the news, indicating, as it does, the apparent intention of the British Government to help set up a Jewish State in the old Promised Land, whose star is now shining es with the hope of a new promise.


