

Cut fish into serving portions and place in baking pan on top of stove, nearly cover with water and boil gent ly, until bones can be removed. Drain and pour heated milk, in which put butter and pepper over fish and serve. Milk can be thickened, if it is preferred that way.

Potato Cakes.

Rice enough cold potatoes to make a cupful, add pint of flour sifted with a half teaspoonful of salt, mix, add water until a little stiffer than biscuit dough, roll on floured board, cut with biscuit cutter. Have frying pan hot Brown on both sides; finish by cook ing in oven a few minutes. Break apart and butter. Repeat by cutting apart and toast.


