WHEAT SAVERS.

Bran Cookies.

One cup sour milk, 1 cup of warm water, 1 cup shortening, 1 cup of table sirup, 1 cup of sugar, 1 pint of flour sifted with two teaspoons baking powder, 1 teaspoon soda dissolved in the milk. Flavor with nutmeg and vanilla. Beat all together, then add enough bran to make a soft dough. Use bran an da little granulated sugar on paper when rolling them. Bake n a moderate oven.

Rolled Oats Cookies.

Two cups sirup, 1 cup sugar, 1 cup fryings, 2 cups warm milk, quarter of a cup of vinegar, 1 package mincemeat, 1 teaspoon cinnamon, 1 teaspoonful of ground cloves, 1 teaspoon salt, 2 eggs, 1 teaspoon soda, 2 teaspoons baking powder, 4 cups rolled oats put through meat grinder, flour to make a soft dough. Bake n moderate oven.

Baked Bananas and Jelly.

Skin the bananas and cut lengthwise in half. Put them in casserole or fire-proof pudding dish. Melt a glass of grape jelly, add juice and pulp of two oranges, then pour all over bananas. Bake in a moderate oven about 20 minutes an dserve hot or cold. Cover edge of dish with a paper frill.

Whipped cream flavored with vanilla essence and sweetened with sugar can be served with bananas if liked.

CHOPPED MEAT DISHES.

Tomatoes with Hamburg Steak

One half lb. Hamburg steak, fry slowly. Mix with bread crumbs and chopped onion, butter and enough tomatoes to make casserole full. This should be almost solid like a meat loaf.

SPANIARDS HAVE NO USE FOR GERMANY

(Canadian Press direct wire.)
Madrid, Feb. 25.—General elections were held throughout Spain yesterday. The liberals appear to have maintained their position, although complete returns have not been received. Republicans carried Madrid and Valencia and the Catalinists were elected at Barcelona.

Disturbances are reported from several places. At Madrid an airplane used by the Maurist conservatives in a publicity stunt fell. The pilot was hurt severely and the machine demolished.

Everywhere the German propagandists appear to have been defeated. They polled only a thousand votes in Madrid.

The Election for Mayor and for Aldermen for the City of Fredericton for the ensuing year will be holden on

**Monday, the 11th Day of
March, 1918,**

At the Polling Places as follows:
Division No. 1.—For all voters residing or owning property above the northwest centre line of Carleton street prolonged, at or near the City Hall, in the said City.

Division No. 2.—For all voters residing or owning property in the remainder of the said City, at or near the County Court House in the said City.

Nominations.

Every Candidate for the office of Mayor or Alderman shall be qualified to vote at the election for which he is nominated, and shall be nominated in writing by at least TWO ratepayers residing in the City of Fredericton, and qualified to vote at the ensuing election for which such Candidate is nominated.

Every nomination paper with the certificate of the City Treasurer shall be filed with the City Clerk or at his office and not later than Four o'clock on the afternoon of MONDAY, the 4th day of March, 1918, and the City Clerk before receiving such nomination paper shall ascertain from the same that the requirements of the Election Act have been complied with.

No Candidate is qualified to be nominated for Alderman unless at the time of nomination he is a resident of the Ward for which he is nominated.

The acceptance of each candidate and the signatures of at least TWO resident qualified voters, who must sign the nomination paper, shall be proved by a witness by affidavit attached to the nomination.

In case of a contest, each elector shall be entitled to vote for ONE candidate for Mayor, for ONE candidate for Alderman for Wellington Ward, for ONE candidate for Alderman for St. Ann's Ward, for ONE candidate for Alderman for Carleton Ward, for ONE candidate for Alderman for Queen's Ward, and for ONE candidate for Alderman for Kings Ward.

Potatoes with Hamburg Steak.

One half lb. Hamburg, 10 large raw potatoes, sliced on the slicer or slaw cutter. Fry hamburg in generous amount of fat, break it apart, sprinkle flour over it; when browned add 1 pint water and cook until thick. Put alternate layers of potatoes and meat and gravy in casserole an dslowly bake for one hour. Season with salt and pepper.

Hamburg Stew.

One half lb. Hamburg, 1 quart of water, 2 tablespoons raw rice, 2 onions 1 cup canned tomatoes, 1 mango, season, cook one hour.
