Vladivostok, Aug. 16-General Diedrichs, the Commander of the Czecho Slovak forces, in pointing out today the great odds his troops are facing estimated the enemy strength at forty thousand men with seventy guns and two hundred machine guns. The status of the Czecho-Slovaks in trans-Baikali is unknown, he said, but it certainly must be desperate. To attain the object sought by the entente allied governments, a substantial force must be sent to the Manchurian front.

Opinion on all sides appears to be that the allied governments are under estimating the magnitude of the task of liberating the Czecho-Slovaks and do not realize the necessity of actual warfare against superior numbers.
