BARKERS POINT IS A FLOURISHING SUBURB

A pretty little place in York County not far from Fredericton, on the opposite side of the St. John river, between South Devon and Marysville is Barker's Point an attractive suburb settlement that has sprung up in the forest. Although scarcely known to the outside world, it is well settled with prosperous up to date farmers, men who work at their different occupations, during the day and work their farms in the evening. Barker's Point has its Post office, two stores, a barber shop and several nice homes, including four concrete dwelling houses complete besides two under construction.

On the property of Mr. Wm. Rickard, Jr., there is a large gravel pit from which the Concrete Company have been getting their gravel and sand for years. A few years ago Mr. R. W. McLellan of this city built a summer residence at this place and established a first class, up-to-date henry where he had expert poultry men employed looking after the raising of his high class poultry of which he had a large number. After going out of the poultry business the buildings were used for the manufacture of concrete blocks, a snug business was established, giving employment to several men. On account of increased business the plant was extended to Fredericton and was recently sold to the Concrete Builders, Ltd. at South Devon.

A Fine Farm

One of the best farms in the vicinity is owned and operated by Mr.

Thomas Dinsmore who daily takes his produce to Fredericton where he finds eager buyers.

Mr. Andrew Rice also conducts a good sized farm near that of Mr. Dinsmore, John Lipsett, John Gill, "Ran" Estabrooks, and the Peppers Brothers also have large farms in this locality besides there are several smaller farms and everybody seems prosperous and all enjoy life.

A Good School

Barker's Point supports a well conducted school house, situated on a pleasant little spot, facing the river to which the children from both ends of the district attend. This term the attendance is larger than usual, several little tots having entered school for the first time. The teacher Mrs. Copland, who started this term has become very popular in the district and is beloved by all her scholars.

Historic Ground

Quite a history is connected with the extreme point of land at the outlet of the Nashwaak into the noble St. John river as at this particular place in the olden days, was situated an old French fort, built by Villebon, while opposite on the Devon shore was the fortress of the British. Many a brisk battle was fought at this place and bullets are found to this day. Old French coins have also been unearthed before now.

Carlow, a few miles beyond Barker's Point is famous for its extensive blueberry plains, also for its well known fishing pools such as the Burpee, Noonan and other places of less importance. It also has several camps, at which Fredericton sports spend many enjoyable hours.

Barker's Point is well adapted as a summer resort it being near the Nashwaak and St. John rivers, only a short distance from Fredericton. It is considered very healthy, the people are sociable, friendly and know how to entertain strangers. For fishing, bathing, boating, and farming this locality is hard to beat. As the Fredericton and Grand Lake spur line runs through the place it may be possible some day to establish a suburban motor service to Fredericton to accommodate the rapidly growing number of people who work in the city and make their homes at Barker's Point.

Now take the grasshopper, for example. No insect on earth more sorely needs to ask daily to be excused for living. The bee has a business; the wasp has a business end. The ant has an investment and a reputation and the grub worm has a grudge. But the grasshopper has only an existence—

When we say aimless, we speak advisedly, for the scientist tells us that when a grasshopper catapults his corporate self into space by the propulsive power of his hinged hopping poles, he has no idea where he is going to light. It may be in the lake or the brush fire or the kerosene can or the pansy bed; it is all the same to him.

Examine his countenance. He looks the perfect fool. At the top of the head two bulging eyes as expressionless as the eye of a dead carp; and below this a nose like a wooden plowshare. This is all. There is no forehead, no brain and no room for one. The grasshopper, we find, is an insect idiot. The best he ever did was to keep out from under foot of his betters.

The grasshopper is negligible except when he multiplies himself with a high power multiplier. Then he becomes a menace. In the back districts of the North African coast, when let alone long enough, he has become "terrible as an army with banners," devouring the land like a fire. 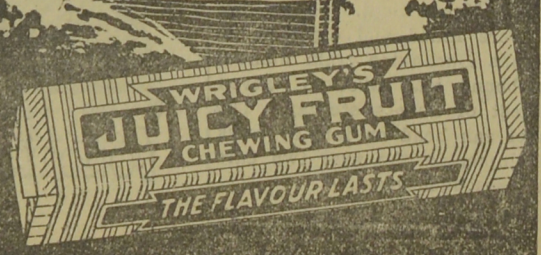
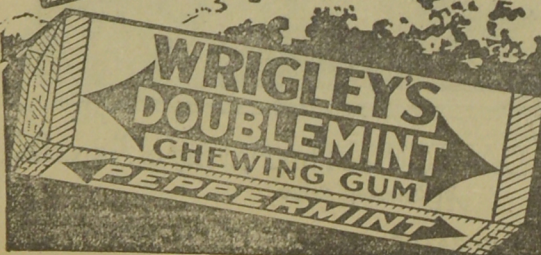
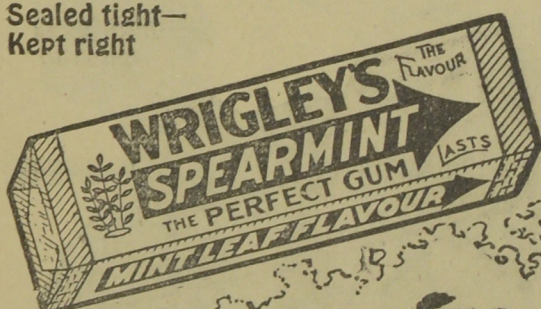
