

JOHN DILLON FIGHTING LEADER OF IRISH PARTY

**Strong in Home Rule Convictions But
Nevertheless a Constitutionalist---Nat-
ural Successor of John Redmond---Noted
as Parliamentary Speaker.**

New York, Mar. 15. — The World today publishes the following special cable from London:

John Dillon's election as chairman of the Irish party means a fighting policy for Home Rule.

Joseph Devlin, the only other possibility for the leadership, declined to allow himself to be put in nomination against Mr. Dillon, who, on his side, was perfectly willing give loyal

service to any member selected by the party. The choice was unanimous, and Mr. Dillon, who of late years has been more closely in touch with popular opinion in Ireland than was John E. Redmond, owing to the latter's close parliamentary ties, will on that account be a more formidable opponent to the Sinn Fein.

Mr. Dillon always has been a Constitutionalist, with the soundest and most deep-rooted democratic convictions. He has denounced again and again, in scathing terms, the Sinn Feiners' ingratitude toward America, Ireland's firmest, most generous and most potent friend in all her struggles.

He also has maintained that the Sinn Fein was the inevitable result of the license allowed the Ulsterites.

Mr. Dillon's feeling toward the Sinn Fein always has been tempered by that knowledge.

A Constitutionalist.

On that account, he has appeared a dangerous extremist to the British politician, whereas he has been, first and always, a constitutionalist, despite his forty years of bitter experience, in his attitude in the British House of Commons toward Ireland.

His election will be unpopular with British political leaders, because it heralds an active policy in Ireland and a strictly critical attitude in the House of Commons, where he is respected but not liked.

He approved the Irish convention, although declining to take part in it, because he thought his presence might give the opposing faction another pretext for irreconcilability.

but he steadfastly used all his influence to secure a settlement of the Home Rule question. He knows the

GOOD SEED IS SCARCE. Place your order now, with your County Council. The Department of Agriculture has ordered 56,000 bushels of oats and 18,000 bushels of wheat.

Oats will be sold for \$1.32 per bushel, in bulk car lots, or \$1.38 in bags in car lots laid down.

Wheat will be sold for \$3.00 per bushel, in bags car lots or f. o. b., distributing point for smaller orders.

Local freights will be paid by purchaser. County Councillors and Agricultural Societies should place car lot orders immediately, stating destination for cars. Delivery not guaranteed unless orders placed within three weeks, because of transportation difficulties.
