to induce settlement upon the land, to encourage increased agricultural prodution, and to aid in the development of our agricultural resources RETURNED SOLDIERS.

In connection with the demobilization of our forces, my advisers recog nize the urgent necessity of provision for the care and vocational training of returned soldiers. Organized effort to provide such legislation to assist them in obtaining it and establishing themselves in civil life is not only important but essential. A department of the government for this purpose has bee constituted and has been vested with necessary powers and duties.

Measures which have been taken by order in council to prevent excessive profits in certain industries and the production of food will be communicated to you, and any change desired will be submitted to you.

A bill for extending the franchise to women, with suitable provisions re specting naturalization, will be submitted and commended to your consider-Your attention will also be invited to a bill to consolidate and amend the acts relating to railways, a bill relating to daylight saving, bills relating to taxation of war profits and of incomes, and other measures

Notwithstanding disappointments in the eastern theatre of war, there is no reason to doubt the triumph of our cause. The effort of the nations included within the British commonwealth is still unbeaten and will so continue to the end.
