





In Odessa, preparations are underway for handling the throngs that are expected to congregate as soon as traveling is safe. Dr. Saalkind, a member of the Jewish National Council for the Ukraine, and former president of the Jewish community of Petrograd says:

"There is no risk of exaggeration in assuming that several hundred thousand, perhaps a million people, are preparing to leave Russia at the first opportunity.'

From Siberia came a request on April 15 to the London Zionist Bureau to obtain permission from the British authorities for a great number of wealthy persons to settle immediately in Palestine. Inquiries have come also from Irkutsk, Omsk, and
