


Another newspaper Las Noticias in commenting on the situation says: "Sir Reginald Tower is being recalled, and Senor Toledo is returning because King George has not received him.

"The occasion for the present situation," it adds, "is the refusal of the British government to recognize the purchase of the Bahia Blanca, but the real cause underlying the crisis is the Argentine Government's hostile attitude towards British capital invested in Argentina.'
