

KEEP THE CORNERS CLEAR

Never Put Furniture in the Corners, is the Latest Advice of Room Decorators.

"Whatever else you do, don't put furniture in the corners," is the wise advice given by a decorator who has had unusual success in the decorating and furnishing of small and medium sized rooms.

Nothing limits a room—cramps and contracts it—as much as occupied corners. With the boundary lines of the room broken or obscured, any suggestion of distance, of spaciousness, is lost. Many rooms are actually distorted in appearance when a piece of furniture is placed in a corner.

Of course if the room is irregular in shape a well placed curved davenport may correct an awkward line, or a desk with a suitable chair near by may be used to good advantage, but these are exceptions that prove the rule.

The average room, unless unusually sparsely furnished—and precious few are—has a tendency to be cramped in appearance, especially those with low ceilings. In well over half the cases clearing every corner so a line from floor to ceiling is visible, remedies the defect to a surprising extent.

Very few pieces of furniture were ever designed to stand in corners, and most of these were originally planned for the corners of very large rooms. A corner cupboard in a small room is a great mistake. So is a grandfather's clock in the corner of a small room, or a grand piano—or even a baby one. These interesting articles require a room of dignified dimensions or they will appear "out of place" and the room itself warped and unsymmetrical.

Even if there is room to keep a book case or chest of drawers only a foot away from a corner, the effect will be better than if the end of the piece be crowded up in the corner close to the two walls.

Experiment with the furniture—try grouping pieces that naturally belong together. See if clear corners aren't possible. They are bound to give a suggestion of spaciousness—a restful, orderly atmosphere that in any room is refreshing.

## NOVEL SILK LINGERIE.

Decidedly unusual is lingerie made of old fashioned striped silk—just the sort of easily laundered soft silk of which little girls' dresses used to be made long ago.

Cool French blue and white pencil striped silk formed a quaint, attractive nightgown and chemise set designed and made by a recent bride for her trousseau.

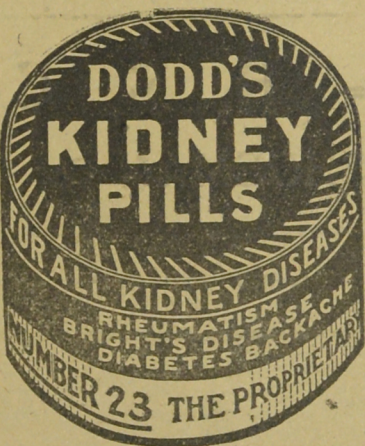
Both garments were severely plain, depending almost entirely on the novelty of the material for their charm. A plain band with stripes running horizontally finished the top of both chemise and gown, with straight bands of the silk for shoulder straps. A butterfly bow of the silk was fastened on the front of each garment.

Gingham pin checked silk could be used instead of the striped, if preferred, a bargain remnant or a discarded summer frock offering possibilities for copying these delightfully different pieces at little or no cost.

Of course a chemise of striped or checked silk may not be worn under any but a thick frock, but to the girl who likes her things to be out of the ordinary this new sort of colorful lingerie will be pleasing—and it is not at all difficult to make.

## RASPBERRY VINEGAR.

It's a popular hot weather beverage. It is easily made at home.

Pour one pint of vinegar over two pints of raspberries. Let the mixture stand for 24 hours; then strain. Add two more pints of raspberries to this juice and again let the mixture stand for 24 hours. Strain again and add two fresh pints of raspberries to the juice and allow the mixture to stand for the third 24 hours.

Then take one pound of granulated sugar to each pint of the liquid, boil the mixture, skim it carefully, bottle it hot and seal it tight.

Despite the high cost of living and the general tendency to boost wages and salaries accordingly. Representative Renton Whidden of Brookline, one of the 71 members in the lower House of the Legislature who voted against raising the members' pay from \$1000 to \$1500, still believes he is not entitled to the raise, and has returned the extra \$500 to the State Treasury.

"I cannot accept more than \$1000 for my services in the Legislature," is all that Mr. Whidden will say about the return of the \$500, which was received in the form of a check by State Treasurer Charles L. Burrill.

The \$500 has been credited to the Legislature Department, House Compensation account, which is the payroll of the House, and will probably be used on some other pay day.
