WILL THEY COME BACK?

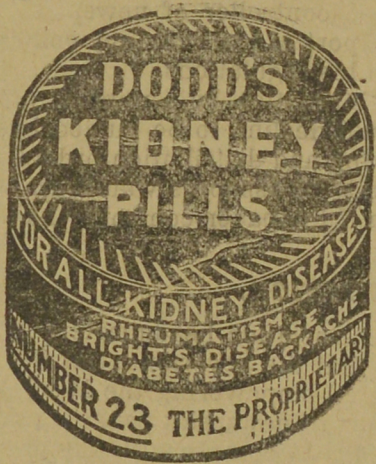

PLENTY OF OUTDOOR WORK FOR RETURNED SOLDIERS

Lumbermen are Offering Jobs in the Woods at \$3.50 per Day
and Board — Canadian Car Foundry Company Employing
Returned Men—Advisory Committees are Doing Good Work
in Connection With Soldiers' Re-establishment.

Reports given by officials of the Department of Soldiers' Civil Re-establishment show that there is plenty of outdoor work still to be had for returned men who will take it.

Openings for several hundreds of men can be found in the open air life of the woods at the rate of \$3.50 per day with board. At Port Arthur 20 per cent of the employees, Canadian Car Foundry Company are returned men. One hundred returned men have recently been placed here in the ship building trade, earning as much as 95 cents per hour. Ship building and the car works provide the greatest number of openings in this vicinity. Work in the freight sheds has absorbed another one hundred, and in the line of temporary work many are at present employed upon construction and in the grain elevators.

It was in the vicinity of Port Arthur that the first railway section gang to be composed entirely of returned men was organized. Here some forty to fifty men worked on construction, the head of the gang being a returned man and every worker down to the least a veteran.

Returned men who have enlisted from this vicinity are in many instances setting an example in the manner in which they have come back willing to fit into any job pending opportunities in their own line rather than wait to swell the ranks of the unemployed. In many instances they have been rewarded by receiving better pay than they anticipated.

A clerical worker looking for some executive position was offered a salary of \$80 per month in a local office. It was not as much as he expected but as at the moment it was the only thing in sight which fitted into his line of experience he set out to try it. He had only been a few hours in the office when he was informed that his salary would be \$125 per month instead of the \$80 previously offered. This was a case of real appreciation of the value of this returned man.

well, as representatives chosen from among the workers. Meetings are held once a month to which different unions are invited to send representatives. Here local matters regarding scale of wages, working conditions and misunderstandings are freely discussed, and the Advisory Board kept in touch with local opportunities and openings suitable to returned men.

In many instances the activities of this Board have been instrumental in raising the scale of wages paid in various lines to meet the need of the employee.

In the Port Arthur Ship building plant about 300 returned men are employed, F. J. Page, Superintendent of this industry, offering every opportunity to veterans who wish for such work.

A large number are also employed with the Hydro-Electric Company both in outside work and in the power house.

There is no doubt, however that the establishment of the Advisory Committee, before mentioned, through which the representatives of both employers and workers may meet to discuss freely all aspects of local conditions, had done much to bring about the splendid feeling which exists in this city towards the returned men.

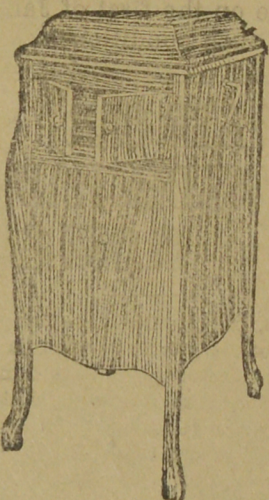
