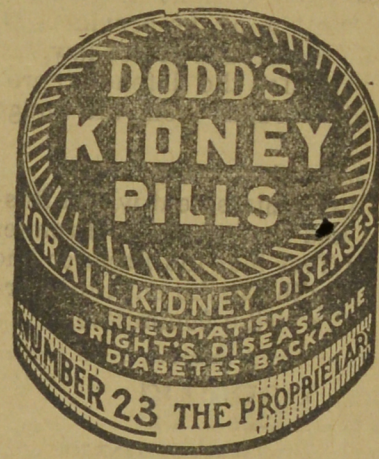

At the meeting of cabinet counsel yesterday afternoon, it is understood the question of Sir Robert's retirement was discussed and the suggestion was then made that he should take an extended holiday. This afternoon, a further meeting of council is to be held. It is possible that an official statement will be issued subsequently.

(Although Sir Robert himself declines to make any statement, doubt is expressed by his friends if the condition of his health will permit him to accept the proposal made by his cabinet colleagues.

Sir Robert is able to attend lighter duties, in fact, he is in attendance at his office nearly every day, but it is questioned if even a further holiday

WATER POWER AT GRAND FALLS IS VERY IMPORTANT

Engineers Estimate That Ninety Thousand Horse Power Can
be Obtained Without Storage Dams—Would Furnish Motive Power for the Canadian National Railways and to Many Other Public and Private Utilities.

(Moncton Transcript)

Now that the Provincial Government can dispose of the water power rights of Grand Falls the question of what should be done about them should receive public consideration. It is not at all likely that the Province or any municipality will undertake to develop the Grand Falls, but in view of the fact that both the Government and the Opposition are committed to the policy of encouraging water power development it is practically certain that any private company which would undertake the project would be able to command very material public assistance. Competent engineers have estimated that at least 90,000 horse power can be obtained without storage dams, while with storage in a 100-foot 30,000 horse power could be made available. The St. John River is about 450 miles long, and has a total drainage area of about 26,000 miles. The mean annual rainfall is low—between 30 and 35 inches; but the contour of the drainage surface with its heavily timbered areas tends to retain the precipitation and to help eke out the low-water flow. The International Commission pertaining to the St. John River has compiled invaluable data covering the whole of the drainage basin, and the investigations made by the United States Geological Survey into the inland waters of the State of Maine, where the river has its source have been of material benefit in the study of its water power possibilities.

Near Grand Falls there are no towns of any industrial importance at present, but Fredericton, St. John, and several considerable towns in Maine are no farther away than some of the cities served by Niagara are from their source of power. One of the possibilities of the development of Grand Falls is that its power may be utilized to operate railways.

It would probably mean that the government as at present constituted would carry on for the present and that it would meet parliament with its following practically intact. Around the east block the names of Hon. Arthur Meighen and Hon. J. A. Calder are still the most prominently mentioned as likely successors to Sir Robert should he insist on retiring.
