## WORKMEN IN SWEDEN ARE PROSPEROUS

Hal. O'Flaherty cables the Chicago News as follows:

Stockholm, Sweden, Nov. 3-Sweden profiting by the lessons of the Russian revolution, is working harder and more contentedly than at any other time since 1914, with prospects for the future as bright as, if not brighter than, those of any other nation in the world. Coming here from England, after viewing nearly a year of continual industrial strife, during which time I have watched the whole community suffer, while this trade union or that gained technical points in the matter of wages or hours through the use of strike weapons, Sweden appears to me a haven of peace. No work men are striking nor are there signs of strikes ahead. Every industry is leaping forward in production, unable to fill a fraction of the orders.

At this time a year ago Sweden suffered intensely as a result of the food shortage, but that condition has been speedily remedied. Every food shop in Stockholm displays such an abundance of good things that it is hard to believe that the Swedes have ever had to eat black bread or do without sugar and butter.

Watch Events Across Baltic

It is almost unbelievable to Americans and Englishmen coming here that any country can enjoy such a large measure of prosperity in view of world conditions. Especially is it surprising to find that Swedish labor, hitherto strongly socialistic in its tendencies has not absorbed some bolshevist propaganda, but conditions prove that the men are steadfastly against anything like communism or sovietism. They have watched the progress of affairs across the Baltic and are now content to proceed along constitutional lines, with an organized representative government as their ideal. Another indication of Sweden's pros perity, evident in almost every part of the country, to the vast amount of building under way. Stockholm undoubtedly has more new buildings under construction than all the rest of the capitals in Europe combined. The civic improvements extend in every direction. The skilled workmen employed in construction express only satisfaction over the conditions generally. They declare that it is possible to live comfortably and support their families upon their earnings. All they ask is that the government shall reduce prices so far as possible. Swift action by the Swedish government to inaugurate the reforms asked for by the laboring classes is indicated by the program just outlined in the riksdag. It is proposed to alleviate the housing shortage by furthering building loans, building houses for state employes and getting city and state co-operation whereever the shortage is acute.
