TWO TIMELY RECIPES.

Recipes calling for sugar may be made without it. When using, add enough to taste. Each jar should have the sugar added when opened so it may have a chance to "ripen" a little, which will serve instead of cooking. Piccalilli.

Chop up 1 peck of green tomatoes and 8 large onions. Add 1 cup of salt, mix well and let stand over night. In the morning drain thoroughly and add two quarts of water and 1 quart of vinegar. Boil 20 minutes and drain through a sieve. Put the vegetables back into the enameled kettle and add 2 quarts of vinegar, 1 pound of sugar, half pound of white mustard seed, 2 level tablespoons of ground black pepper, 2 level tablepoons of ground cinnamon, 1 level tablespoon ground ginger, 1 level tablespoon whole allspice, 1 level tablespoon whole cloves, half teaspoon of ground cayenne pepper. Boil all together for 15 minutes or until the vegetables are tender stirinto jars and seal while hot.


