

OF INTEREST TO WOMEN

TWO TIMELY RECIPES.

Recipes calling for sugar may be made without it. When using, add enough to taste. Each jar should have the sugar added when opened so it may have a chance to "ripen" a little, which will serve instead of cooking.

Piccalilli.

Chop up 1 peck of green tomatoes and 8 large onions. Add 1 cup of salt, mix well and let stand over night. In the morning drain thoroughly and add two quarts of water and 1 quart of vinegar. Boil 20 minutes and drain through a sieve. Put the vegetables back into the enameled kettle and add 2 quarts of vinegar, 1 pound of sugar, half pound of white mustard seed, 2 level tablespoons of ground black pepper, 2 level tablespoons of ground cinnamon, 1 level tablespoon ground ginger, 1 level tablespoon whole allspice, 1 level tablespoon whole cloves, half teaspoon of ground cayenne pepper.

Boil all together for 15 minutes or until the vegetables are tender, stirring often to prevent scorching. Put into jars and seal while hot.

Tomato Catsup.

Wash and cut up a quantity of tomatoes. It is not necessary to remove the skins. Place in kettle without any water and boil until thoroughly soft. Mash through a fine sieve until only seeds and skins remain. To each gallon of this liquid add three level tablespoons of salt and one-fourth of a tablespoon of red pepper. Place in kettle again and suspend in it a little flannel bag containing for each gallon 2 level tablespoons of whole allspice, 4 level tablespoons of unground white or yellow mustard seed, 1 level tablespoon of whole cloves, 2 level tablespoons of unground celery seed and 1 ounce of stick cinnamon. Boil for about half an hour.

USEFUL KNOWLEDGE.

White enameled furniture may be cleaned with turpentine and the gloss will be uninjured. Wet a soft cloth with turpentine, rub the spots off the woodwork and rub dry with another cloth.

A floor covered with a good linoleum should hold its own for at least five years. It needs no soap or any strong cleansing agent. A simple wiping with a cloth just moist with warm water is all that is needed.

The lunch box or basket should be fresh and odorless. Always empty the receptacle at night and allow it to air thoroughly. In case of the basket, scald out once or twice a week, drying thoroughly afterward.

Chemise frocks made with kimono sleeves are still smart.

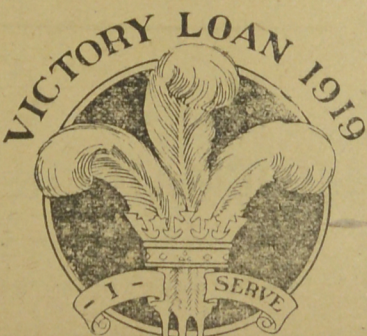
A smart little frock of brown tricot-lette has orange pipings.

MONCTON'S BUILDING BOOM

Moncton, N. B., Oct. 16.—Moncton's building boom is still increasing, even as the season closes, and will run well into next year. Already this month twelve new building permits have been issued and within a few days permits for a new large theatre and two cement garages will be issued. In Moncton this year so far sixty-three permits for garages have been issued, several of which are public garages. Since New Year's day 97 single dwelling houses and 62 double houses have been erected and 85 permits for building additions issued, which cover several cases of single house being changed into double; 47 new stores and offices are being erected. The total number of permits so far is 386 and the approximate value of new buildings exclusive of the Canadian National Railway extensions considerably exceeds \$2,000,000.

WILL EXTEND RESTRICTIONS

Washington, Oct. 16.—By an overwhelming majority the House today passed the bill extending for one year war time passport restrictions, so as to keep radicals and undesirable aliens out of the United States.

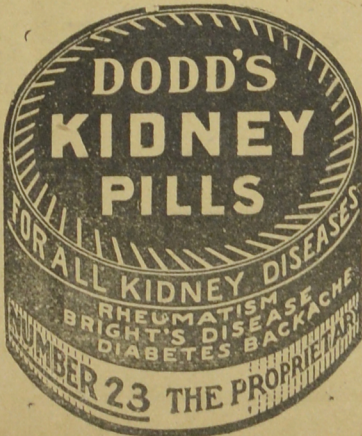
