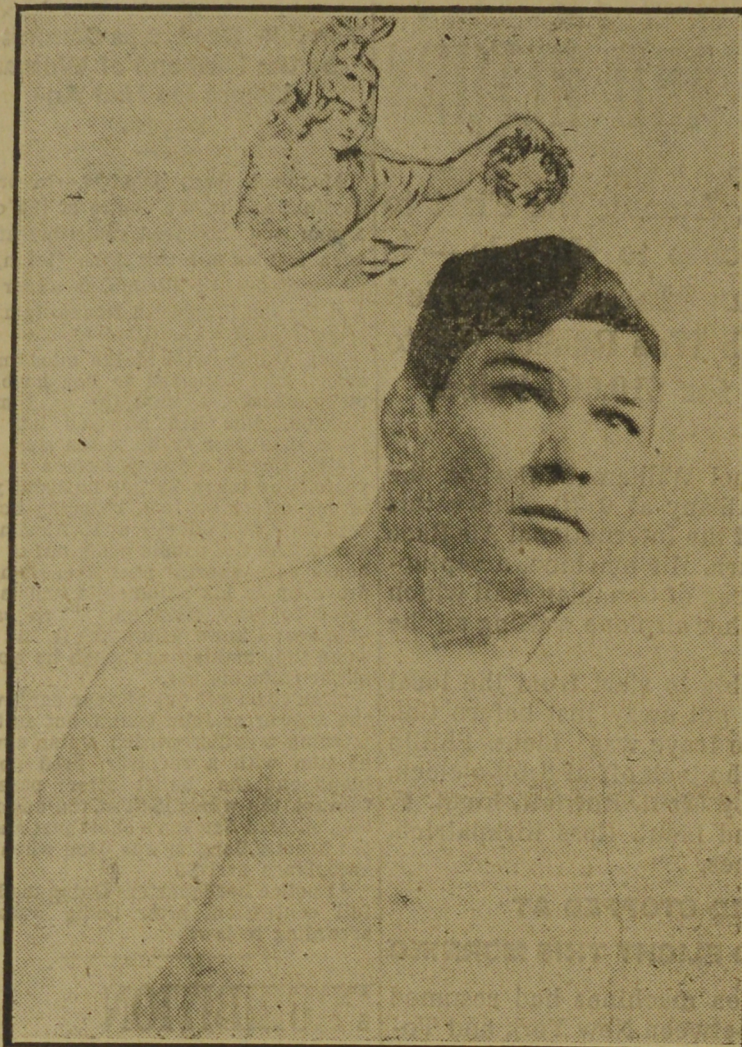
GREEK HEAVY

following tribute to Lady Bathurst:

"The gallant knights of the pen who
daily do her bidding find her wise
counsel of great assistance and com-
fort. Her intimate knowledge of home
and foreign politics, of naval and mili-
tary affairs and of the complications
of the land question is a revelation in
female capacity.

"Jealous folk point to the fact that
the ex-editors of the Morning Post
are numerous; there have been four
in a short span. Feminine caprice,
however has little to do with her
choice. She picks her staff as Queen
Victoria chose her houses of old, and
displays indeed many of the qualities
of that great ruler.

"Travelled, widely read and an ac-
complished linguist, she makes the
Morning Post a considerable factor in
the battle beginning in Fleet street
this morning. Left to the care of the
board of directors of the Morning
Post, one a strong radical, the prop-
erty might have suffered extinction."

trance of Lord Northcliffe in the 2
cent morning newspaper field with the
London Times. His greatest target in
the campaign was the Morning Post
but Lady Bathurst has been highly
successful not only in maintaining the
position of her paper but in improving
it.

Daily Mail the Morning Post, under
Lady Bathurst, has been able to im-
prove its position in recent years
without changing its policy.

Lady Bathurst takes an active in-
terest in the general management of
her property. She sees to it that the
policy of independent conservatism
adopted by her father is maintained.
Lady Bathurst has been one of Mr.
Balfour's most strenuous critics for

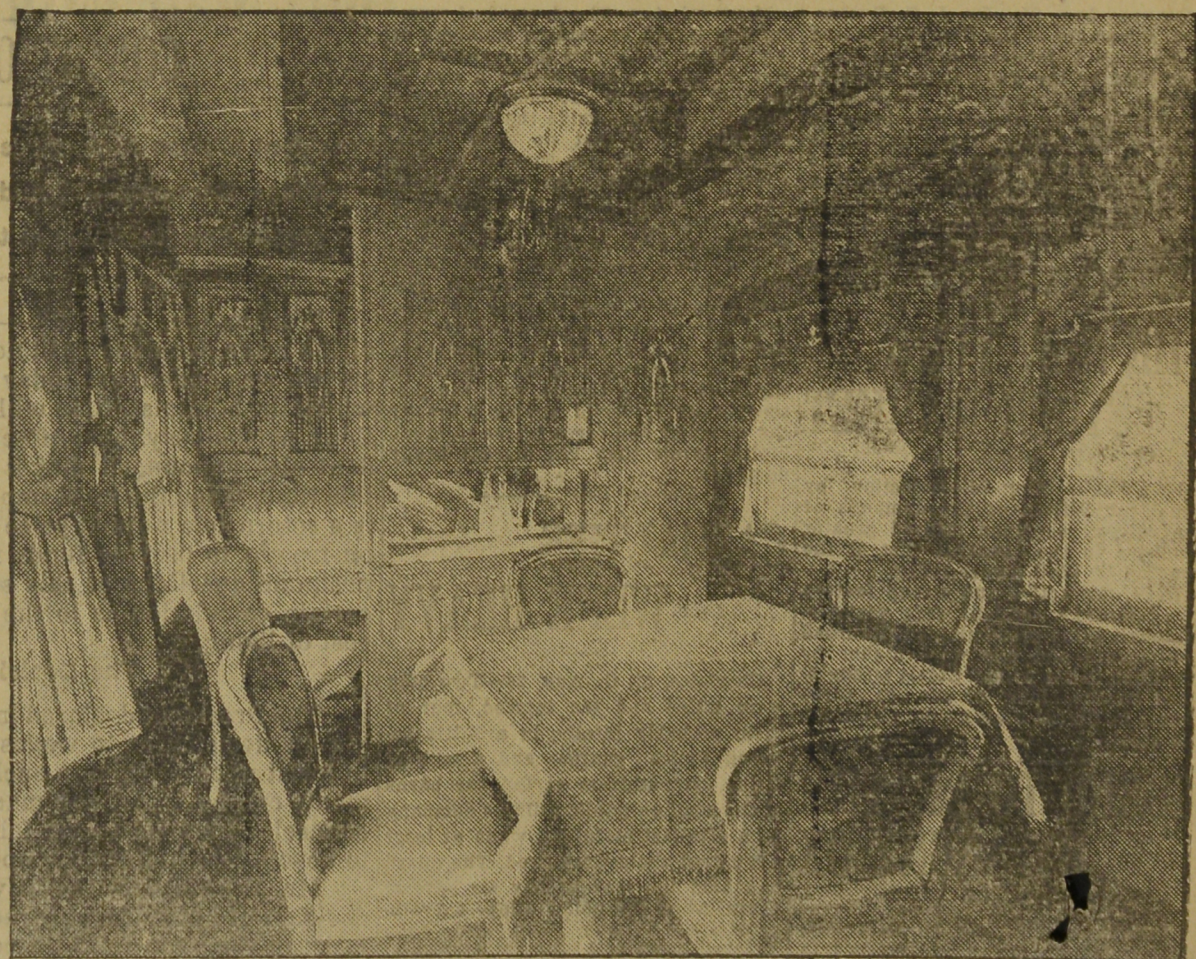
