> A burst of laughter greeted the reading of the resolution by Mrs. Olive Stott Gabriel, chairman of the Resolation Committee. This was quickly followed by loud applause and the resolution was put to the convention. Jumping to her feet Mrs. Wentz

said: "We are in the hands of designing designers who are giving free rein to indecent expressions in dress. And you must remember there is no longer the plea of cloth conservation to make dresses shorter and lower.

"I wish to make a distinction between a decollete dress and one that is indecently cut low. A decollete may be modest, but evning dresses of the prevailing fashion are anything but that. They show bare neck, bare arms and bare backs, which are disgusting.
