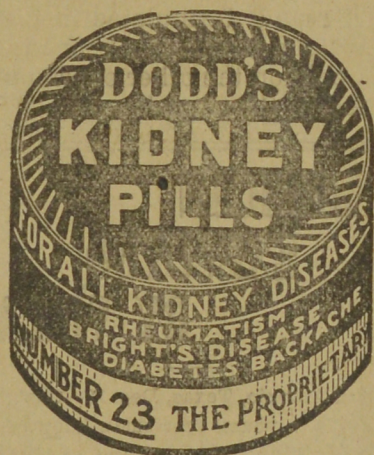

REDS BEING  
SENT BACK TO  
HOME LAND

New York, Dec. 13.—A United States transport will leave this port within ten days for Russia, carrying several hundred Reds held for deportation. Emma Goldman and Alexander Berkman will be among them. Emma Goldman whose appeal against deportation is before the United States Supreme Court, withdrew her application yesterday on hearing from her lawyer that the "soviet ark" would start within less than two weeks with most of the leaders of the Russian Red government in this country.

MUCH SPECULATION AS  
TO UNIONIST LEADERSHIP

A Change at the Present Time is Beseet With Many Difficulties

—A Reorganization Will Mean the Retirement of Several Ministers—Session of Parliament May Be Delayed Until the Spring Months—Hon. Arthur Meighen Believed to Have The Best Claim.

Ottawa, Dec. 15.—It is frankly admitted in government circles that a change in the Prime Ministership at the present time is a matter beset with many complications. If, as is anticipated, the reorganization which would follow the selection of a new Unionist leader, leads to the retirement from the cabinet of several ministers, their successors in office would have to seek re-election. Under the provisions of the by-elections act passed at the session of parliament held last winter, it takes at least forty days to prepare the new lists in constituencies where such contests would be held.

Should there be several new ministers awaiting the verdict of their constituents, the new government would in all probability not be prepared to meet parliament, and the session of parliament would be delayed until the spring months. Members of the present cabinet retained in the new government would not have to seek re-election even should they shift their portfolios.

## Caucus to be Held

The decision to leave the matter of the choice of a successor to Sir Robert to a Unionist caucus makes speculation at this time as to who the next Prime Minister is likely to be more or less futile and it is quite possible that there would be uncertainty about the matter until the gathering is held and the vote taken. Should Sir Thomas White be in the running, however, it is believed that his chances would be good, as it is generally realized that his leadership of the Unionists during the absence of Sir Robert Borden at the Peace Conference gave general satisfaction to the rank and file of the membership.

The Ottawa Journal, discussing the names of Sir Thomas White, the Hon. Arthur Meighen and Hon. J. A. Calder, in connection with the leadership, expresses the view that Mr. Meighen would appear to have both greater claim and chance for the post.

Sir Robert was back in his office this morning, but declined to make any statement as to his intentions.

## Many Names Mentioned.

In political circles at the capital today nearly half the members of the cabinet were mentioned in connection with the leadership. In addition to those already referred to, Sir Henry Drayton, the new Minister of Finance, Hon. Mr. Rowell, president of the Privy Council, Hon. J. A. Calder, Minister of Immigration and Colonization, Sir George Foster and Sir James Lougheed, are being discussed as possibilities. Sir Henry Drayton has been regarded by many of his friends as a prospective Prime Minister, but the retirement of Sir Robert Borden coming before he has had an opportunity to gain parliamentary experience, may militate against his chances.

On the other hand it is thought to be not improbable that when the caucus foregathers, Mr. Rowell, because of his parliamentary record and experience, may have a considerable num-

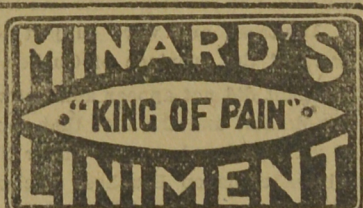
