

## SEASONABLE RECIPES

## Molasses Pudding.

Beat one cup of molasses and one-half cup of melted butter to a cream, add one cup of milk, two well beaten eggs, one teaspoon of cinnamon, one-fourth teaspoon of nutmeg and last of all 3½ cups of flour mixed and sifted with one-half teaspoon of soda and one-half-teaspoon of salt. Turn into a buttered mold and boil three hours. Serve with liquid sauce.

## Sour Cream Biscuits.

Mix and sift three cups of sifted flour with four teaspoons of baking powder and one teaspoon of salt; work in three tablespoons of shortening and moisten with about one cup of sour cream in which one-half teaspoon of soda has been dissolved. Knead slightly, cut and pat into shape and bake in a quick oven.

## Nut Cookies.

Place in a mixing bowl one cup of syrup, one-half cup of shortening, one cup of finely chopped nuts, one-half cup of milk and water, one teaspoon of nutmeg, two teaspoons of baking powder, four to five cups of flour.

Form to a stiff dough and then knead well. Form into balls the size of a small walnut and press very flat between the palms of the hands. Brush with syrup and dip in finely ground nuts. Bake for twelve minutes in a moderate oven.

## Cinnamon Buns.

To make cinnamon buns put one pound of flour into a pan, make a hole in the centre into which pour one tablespoonful of yeast and one cupful of milk slightly warmed and flavored with a little cinnamon. Mix these together with a little of the flour and six ounces of butter and beat up four eggs; add this to the sponge, knead all together. The dough must be again allowed to rise. When it has risen well in about an hour's time, put small balls of this mixture on a well greased oven tin about two or three inches apart. This dough being light, will fall into required shape. Sprinkle with sugar and cinnamon on top. Bake in a moderate oven.

## HELPS IN THE HOME.

New lamp wicks soaked in vinegar will not smoke.

If you are growing bulbs for winter blooming, remember that they must have five to eight weeks to get their roots well started.

Good polishing cloths are made from old velvet.

A freshly whitewashed cellar will give butter a strong taste.

Always fill a milk bottle with water the moment it is emptied; it is much easier to wash afterwards.

When you rip an old garment, first cut a few stitches with the scissors; then pin the material to your knee and rip with a sharp knife.

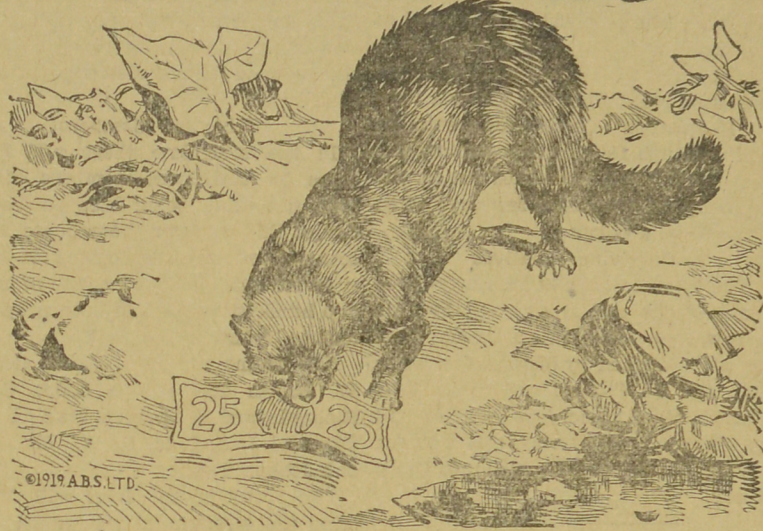
