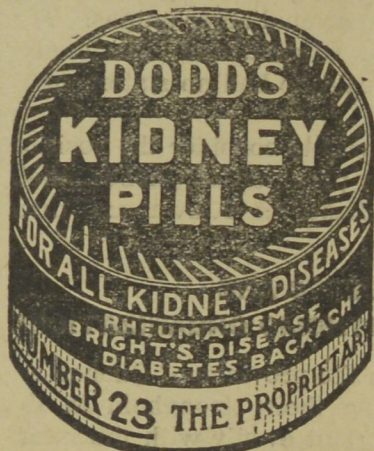

THROUGH NOON TRAIN, ST. JOHN TO HALIFAX

Nos. 13 and 14 Trains to Run Between St. John and Halifax—To Make Boston Connections.

Time Table changes effective on Canadian National Lines November 30 will affect St. John in one important particular. Trains Nos. 13 and No. 14, now running between St. John and Moncton, will run (daily except Sunday) between St. John and Halifax as through trains, and not connecting with the Ocean Limited at Moncton.

No. 14 will leave St. John at 1.40 p.m. after the arrival of the Boston train, carrying through Boston sleeper for Halifax, arriving there at 11.40 p.m. No. 13 will leave Halifax at 7.40 a.m. (except Sunday) and carry the through Boston sleeper to St. John, arriving at 5.35 p.m. This service should prove most satisfactory to the travelling public. A Standard C. N. R. Diner will run between Halifax and Moncton on these trains.

C. N. R. trains in and out of Fredericton are not affected by these train changes.

LIBERALS TO ORGANIZE EVERY CONSTITUENCY

Ottawa, Dec. 9.—A comprehensive but compact system of organization, coupled with a campaign of education by publication and word of mouth, has been decided upon by the convention of Liberals which has just finished its convention at the capital.

Delegates declare that the gathering was eminently successful, and have returned to their homes imbued with an enthusiastic desire to further the Liberal cause along the lines laid down at the conference.

Steps will immediately be taken to organize a central national bureau at Ottawa with general secretary at the head and with a competent staff for the purpose of co-ordinating local and provincial organization and to prepare literature and pamphlets setting forth the Liberal platform.

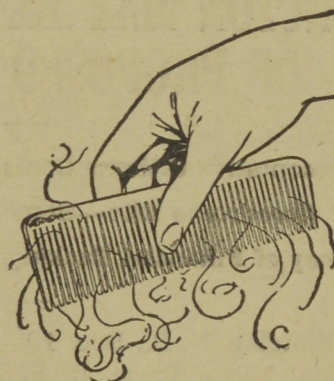
Nine vice-presidents, one for each province, will be appointed to work in conjunction with the National Secretary and to act as a medium between him and the provincial organization. A committee of six will be selected in each province whose function it will be to provide ways and means for the carrying on of the work in hand and for the financing of the central bureau. One of the six to be selected by the provincial premier or leader of the opposition, the other five by the provincial associations.

It is not intended that the appointment of a general secretary shall imply centralization; organization rather shall start from the local and work up to the provincial as was done in Ontario a sort of co-ordinated autonomy is aimed at and the central office will secure the co-ordination with the advice of the vice-presidents.

The conference decided that there should be no string upon any funds contributed for the purposes of organization. The party does not desire, in the event of its being called upon to form a ministry that their hands shall be tied because they have handled money the giving of which was tacitly conditional upon the carrying out of the wishes of the givers.

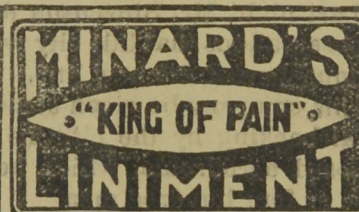
