

William LeBaron formerly of Collier's Weekly, author of "Apple Blossoms" and "The Very Idea," and one of the best known magazine men in the country, has become editor of Cosmopolitan Productions.

CATHOLICS TO
BE REPRESENTED

Rome, Dec. 9.—Catholics will be given the portfolios of Instruction and Justice in the Italian cabinet as a result of the ministerial crisis, according to the Epoca, which says that, in addition, six Catholic under secretaries of state will be chosen.

Paris, Dec. 8.—The supreme council notes to Germany dealing with the peace treaty were delivered to Baron Von Dersner, head of the German delegation this evening.

Germany is warned for the last time that denunciation of the armistice would give the allies armies all the latitude for necessary military measures. "In this spirit we await without delay signature of the protocol and the exchange of ratifications," the Germans are told.

Toronto, Dec. 8.—Forty-nine new cases of smallpox were reported during the last twenty-four hours to the civic health department here, and only six new cases were discharged.

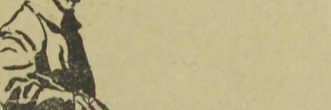

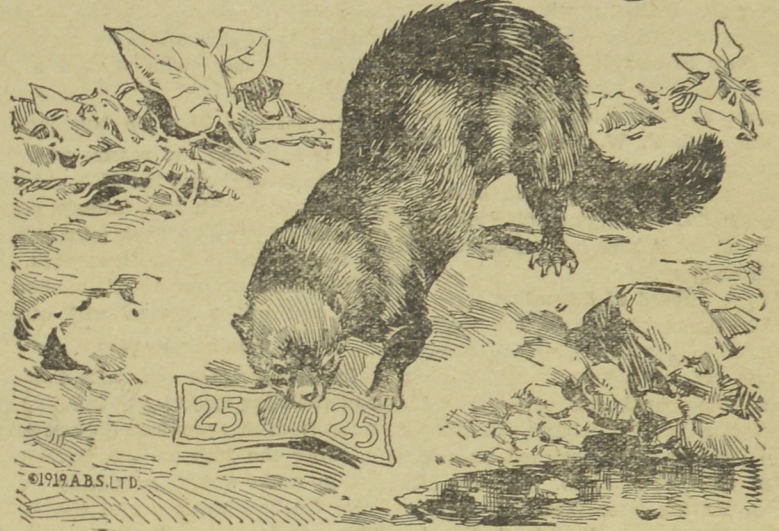
