TO WOMEN

TO COOK A TONGUE.

Smoked Tongues Should be Freshened in Cold Water Before Being Cooked.

It is a good idea to change the water wice, each time just as it comes to the scalding point. Fresh tongues may be put directly into the boiling water. In either case the tongue should be cooled slowly-on the back of the coal stove and over the simmer if you use a gas stove.

When the tongue is tender, tak from the fire and let the tongue cool in the kettle. When cool take from the liquor and remove the skin. If you want to have a very delicious flav or, add to the water in which tongue is cooked a bouquet of sweet herbs and three cloves as well as pepper It should not be salted while cooking Some cooks also add an onion and a carrot to the water in which it is cooked.

A tongue cooked tender in this fashon may be served in thin slices cold a white sauce, or it may be baked. To do this brush the cooked tongue with butter or cooking oil and place in dripping pan. Cover the tongue with buttered bread crumbs and bake for 20 minutes, basting from time to time with hot water and melted butter, or with a little leftover chicken stock.

Braised Tongue.

Here is a recipe for making braised tongue that comes from the notebook of a famous cook:

Wash the tongue, skewer it into shape, put into boiling salted water flour, slice one onion and brown it in hot fat, then slightly brown the tongue in the same fat. Put the tongue and onion in a pan with a tight cover, add two tablespoonfuls of turnip and car rot, cut fine two cloves and pepper corns, a bit of celery root, or a sprig of parsley, or a tablespoonful of whole sweet herbs, or, if this seems like too much trouble, salt, pepper and onions will make a very palatable seasoning.

Half cover with boiling water, put on the cover and cook slowly in mod erate oven two hours. Turn the tongue after the first hour and add more wa ter if necessary. There should be about a pint when the tongue is done Remove the fat from the gravy and thicken the water with flour wet in cold water. Add more salt if needed. and one cup of tomato if the broth is not sufficiently seasoned. Put the

USEFUL COOKING HINTS.

When peeling apples for pies, place them in a basin, pour boiling water over them and cover. Leave for ten minutes and the skins will come off quite easily, saving trouble and time. This is also a more economical way of peeling them, as there is no waste.

12 Corner Westmorland and Aperdeen Do not take too thick a rind off in paring potatoes. The best part of the 12 Corner Northumberland and Saunpotato is near the skin. Tomatoes should always be skinned 17 Corner King and Northumperland before using for salad. To do this easily, place the fruit in a basin and pour boiling water over; let it stand a minute. You will then find that the 24 Corner Queen and Westmorland skin can be removed without any trou-
