APPLE GREEN.

An Alluring Shade for Summer, and the New Types in This Color Have Attracted Considerable Attention.

There has been a race between lemon yellow and apple green since the season began. Each has its hot weather appeal.

It is said that in Europe the bright green has been overrun by the lemon yellow but the American tendency is toward the former color.

Novelty Blouses in Green.

A year ago there was an attempt to bring in colored blouses with tailored suits, after a half-dozen years of white ones. The attempt partly succeeded, but the desire for colored bodices reached its apex when the outside blouse was substituted for the regulation American shirtwaist.

The best designers of tailored suits persuaded their patrons to wear these outside blouses in apple green, lemon yellow, rose pink, mauve and Chinese blue with suits of any color, especially those in black and white checked wool.

The exclusive woman wears the colored shirtwaist when she wears the outside blouse at all.

The blouse that is worn with the separate skirt has become a garment of such importance that it is not part of a costume as much as it is the dominating factor of a costume.

When it is in bright green, it is worn in the country wherever fashionable people foregather; when it is lemon yellow, it is sworn to less formal occasions.

The designers, knowing that women want these tunic blouses in bright colors, have put their ingenuity to work to achieve something that is actually alluring and has a chance of success.

The overcareless smock type of blouse is not chosen; it is left to the artists in their studios.

The French workman's blouse is no longer a pattern for the American woman's street costume. She leans toward the Orient.

The majority of these blouses look like Arabian coats. Some are buttoned down the front, with wide, skirted peplums, and others are as slim and straight as a cuirass of metal.

Taffeta a Good Fabric.

As the summer progresses and taffeta flickers its way throughout all costume, the average woman leans toward it for special garments, if not for workaday ones.

The public has come to the conclusion that taffeta should not be abused as it was a decade ago, when it was made into all kinds of cheap one-piece frocks and separate skirts. It is kept for the gay hours of life and is not asked to give more than its share of service.

Therefore the bright colors in this silk are more sought after than black. This is especially true when the material is used for tunic blouses.

CAPTURED A HUN PILL BOX AND WON V. C.

Montreal, July 3.—Among the soldiers returning on the Grampian, which docked here this morning, was Lieut. G. H. Mullin, who won the Victoria Cross at Passchendaele in October 1917 for capturing a German pill box with its store of occupants, single-handed.

Lieut. Mullin's home is in Moosemin, Sask. He modestly said that his performance was mere luck. In his advance on the pill box, he said, his clothes were struck by twenty bullets, while one hit the hilt of a German revolver he had picked up and stuck in his belt.

The Grampian was brought to port by Captain James Turnbull, who has commanded a number of C. P. O. S. ships, including the ill-fated Empress of Ireland, and has sunk a couple of German submarines. He was port convoy officer at Sydney, C. P., from 1917.
